## What you will need:

RED HEART® Fashion Crochet  
Metallics, Size 5: 2 balls 410S  
Silver/Silver

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:  
2.25mm [US B-1]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 28 sts = 4" (10 cm).  
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any  
size hook to obtain the gauge  
given.

# Adult's Royal Crown

*Everyone deserves to feel like royalty and wear  
this beautiful crocheted crown, at least for a  
day. Crochet thread with a shiny silver filament  
gives it a wonderful sparkle. For a child's size  
crown see pattern LC3717.*

**Finished Size:** 5¾" (14.5 cm) tall x 21½"  
(54.5 cm) in circumference. One size fits  
most adults.

## Special Stitch

**V-st:** (Dc, ch 2, dc) in same st.  
dc3tog: (yo, insert hook into next dc, yo, pull  
through st, yo, pull through 2 loops) 3 times,  
yo, pull through all 4 loops on hook  
picot cluster: [Ch 4, sc in 4th ch from hook\*\*  
3 times.

## Note

One pattern repeat = approximately 2" (5 cm).  
Vary size of crown by adding or removing 15  
ch sts on the foundation ch.

## CROWN

Ch 150, and without twisting, slip st in first ch  
to form ring.

**Round 1:** Ch 1, working in back bars of ch sts,  
sc in each ch around – 150 sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with  
a slip st in first sc – 150 sc.

**Round 3:** Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), skip next 2  
sc, \*dc in next sc, ch 2, skip next 2 sc; repeat  
from \* around, join with a slip st in 3rd ch of  
beg ch-5 – 50 ch-2 spaces.

**Round 4:** Ch 1, sc in first st, \*2 sc in next ch-2  
space, sc in next dc; repeat from \* around,  
ending last repeat at \*\*, join with a slip st in  
first sc – 150 sc.

**Round 5:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 8 sc, \*ch  
5, skip next 5 sc, dc in each of next 5 sc, ch  
5, skip next 5 sc\*\*, sc in each of next 15 sc;  
repeat from \* around, ending last repeat at \*\*,  
sc in each of last 7 sc, join with a slip st in first  
sc – 10 ch-5 spaces; 5 pattern repeats.

**Round 6:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 7 sc, \*ch 5,  
skip next sc, dc in next ch-5 space, dc in each  
of next 2 dc, ch 1, skip next dc, dc in each of  
next 2 dc, dc in ch-5 space, ch 5, skip next  
sc\*\*, sc in each of next 13 sc; repeat from \*

around, ending last repeat at \*\*, sc in each of  
last 6 sc, join with a slip st in first sc.

**Round 7:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 6 sc, \*ch 5,  
skip next sc, skip next ch-5 space, dc in each  
of next 3 dc, ch 5, dc in next ch-1 space, ch 5,  
dc in each of next 3 dc, ch 5, skip next ch-5  
space, skip next sc\*\*, sc in each of next 11  
sc; repeat from \* around, ending last repeat at  
\*\*, sc in each of last 5 sc, join with a slip st in  
first sc.

**Round 8:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 5 sc, \*ch 5,  
skip next sc, skip next ch-5 space, dc in each  
of next 3 dc, ch 3, sc in next ch-5 space, ch  
10, sc in ch-5 space, ch 3, dc in each of next  
3 dc, ch 5, skip next ch-5 space, skip next  
sc\*\*, sc in each of next 9 sc; repeat from \*  
around, ending last repeat at \*\*, sc in each of  
last 4 sc, join with a slip st in first sc.

**Round 9:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 4 sc, \*ch 5,  
skip next sc, skip next ch-5 space, dc in each  
of next 3 dc, ch 3, skip next ch-3 space, 25  
dc in next ch-10 space, ch 3, skip next ch-3  
space, dc in each of next 3 dc, ch 5, skip next  
ch-3 space, skip next sc\*\*, sc in each of next  
7 sc; repeat from \* around, ending last repeat  
at \*\*, sc in each of the last 3 sc, join with a  
slip st in first sc.

**Round 10:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, \*ch 5,  
skip next sc, skip next ch-3 space, dc in each  
of next 3 dc, ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 3, skip  
next 2 dc, dc in next dc] 8 times, ch 3, skip  
next ch-3 space, dc in each of next 3 dc, ch 5,  
skip next ch-5 space, skip next sc\*\*, sc in each  
of next 5 sc; repeat from \* around, ending last  
repeat at \*\*, sc in each of last 2 sc, join with a  
slip st in first sc.

**Round 11:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sc, \*ch 5,  
skip next sc, skip next ch-5 space, dc in each  
of next 3 dc, ch 3, skip next ch-3 space, dc in  
next dc, [3 dc in next ch-3 space, dc in next  
dc] 8 times, ch 3, skip next ch-3 space, dc in  
each of next 3 dc, ch 5, skip next ch-5 space,

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skip next sc\*\*, sc in each of next 3 sc; repeat from \* around, ending last repeat at \*\*, sc in last sc, join with a slip st in first sc.

**Round 12:** Ch 5 (counts as dtr) \*skip next ch-5 space, dc in each of next 3 dc, ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 3, skip next 3 dc, V-st in next dc] 7 times, ch 3, skip next 3 dc, dc in next dc, ch 3, skip next ch-3 space, dc in each of next 3 dc\*\*, skip next sc\*\*, dtr in next sc; repeat from \* around, ending last repeat at \*\*, join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-5.

**Round 13:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), \*dc3tog over next 3 sts, (ch 3, sc) in each of next 2 ch-3 spaces, ch 3, [(2 dc, picot cluster, 2 dc) in next V-st, ch 2, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 2] 6 times, (2 dc, picot cluster, 2 dc) in next V-st, (ch 3, sc) in each of next 2 ch-3 spaces, ch 3, dc3tog over next 3 dc\*\*, dc in next dtr; repeat from \* around, ending last repeat at \*\*, join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-3. Fasten off.

## Finishing

Weave in ends. Starch and block to fit.

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; dc = double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); ( ) = work directions in parentheses into same st; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.



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
