What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each 368 Paddy Green A, 316 Soft White B, and 706 Perfect Pink C

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle, universal-size jar

GAUGE: 13 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 12 rounds = 4" [10 cm] in half double crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given.

BUY YARN



RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yds (333 m); stripes, prints, multis and heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yds (215 m); flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



Gnome Jar Topper

If you have someone with a sweet tooth on your gift list, a jar full of candy can't go wrong! Top it off with this whimsical gnome and you'll have a personalized present in no time!

To fit universal-size mason jar lid: 2 3/4" (70mm) diameter

To fit wide-mouth mason jar: 3 3/8" (86mm) diameter

HAT

With A, make an adjustable ring as follows: Wrap yarn around your finger with the yarn tail to the left and under the working yarn. Insert hook through the circle from front to back. Yarn over using the working yarn and pull through loop.

Note: You can substitute the adjustable ring as follows: Ch 3, join to 1st ch with a slip st.

Round 1: 6 hdc in adjustable ring, join to 1st hdc; pull starting end tightly to close - 6 hdc.

Round 2: Hdc in each hdc around; join to 1st hdc.

Round 3: 2 hdc in 1st hdc, hdc in next hdc, *2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next hdc; repeat from * once more; join to 1st hdc with a slip st - 9 hdc.

Round 4: Hdc in each hdc around; join to 1st hdc - 9 hdc.

Round 5: 2 hdc in 1st hdc, hdc in each of next 2 hdc, *2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each of next 2 hdc; repeat from * once more; join to 1st hdc - 12 hdc.

Round 6: Hdc in each hdc around; join to 1st hdc - 12 hdc.

Round 7: 2 hdc in 1st hdc, hdc in each of the next 3 hdc, *2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each of next 3 hdc; repeat from * once more; join to 1st hdc - 15 hdc.

Round 8: Hdc in each hdc around; join to 1st hdc - 15 hdc.

Round 9: 2 hdc in 1st hdc, hdc in each of next 4 hdc, *2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each of next 4 hdc; repeat from * once more; join to 1st hdc - 18 hdc.

Round 10: Hdc in each hdc around; join to 1st hdc.

Round 11: 2 hdc in 1st hdc, hdc in each of next 5 hdc, *2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each of next 5 hdc; repeat from * once more; join to 1st hdc - 21 hdc.

Round 12: Hdc in each hdc around; join to 1st hdc.

Round 13: 2 hdc in 1st hdc, hdc in each of next 6 hdc, *2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each of next 6 hdc; repeat from * once more; join to 1st hdc - 24 hdc.

Round 14: Hdc in each hdc around; join to 1st hdc.

Round 15: 2 hdc in 1st hdc, hdc in each of next 7 hdc, *2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each of next 7 hdc; repeat from * once more; join to 1st hdc - 27 hdc.

Round 16: Hdc in each hdc, around; join to 1st hdc.

Round 17: 2 hdc in 1st hdc, hdc in each of next 8 hdc, *2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each of next 8 hdc; repeat from * once more; join to 1st hdc - 30 hdc.

Round 18: Hdc in each hdc around; join to 1st hdc.

Round 19: Working in front loops, 2 hdc in 1st hdc, hdc in each of next 9 hdc, * 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each of next 9 hdc; repeat from * once more; join to 1st hdc - 33 hdc.

Round 20: Hdc in each hdc around; join to 1st hdc. Fasten off.

BEARD

Attach B to a back loop from Round 19 of Hat.

Round 1: Ch 1, hdc in back loop of each hdc; join to 1st hdc - 33 hdc.

Round 2: 2 hdc in 1st hdc, hdc in each of next 10 hdc, * 2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in each of next 10 hdc; repeat from * once more; join to 1st hdc - 36 hdc.

Round 3: *Ch 10, slip st in next st; repeat from * around. Fasten off.

LM5760 Gnome Jar Topper

NOSE

With **C**, make an adjustable ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, (2 sc, 1 dc, 2 sc, 1 dc) into ring; pull ring tightly and join.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for attaching.

FINISHING

Using yarn needle and long tail, attach the NOSE to the BEARD just below the HAT.

Weave in all loose ends. Place the lid cover on top of the jar.

A, B, C = Colors A, B, C; **ch** = chain;
dc = double crochet; **hdc** = half double
crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single
crochet; **st(s)** = stitch (es); * = repeat
whatever follows the * as indicated.
