## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:**  
316 Soft White

**Susan Bates® Double-Pointed  
Knitting Needles (set of 5):**  
6.0mm [US 10]

Stitch marker  
Yarn needle  
Mason Jar (32 oz / 1 quart)

**GAUGE:** 18 sts = 4" [10 cm];  
24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in 2 X  
2 Rib. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**  
Use any size needles to  
obtain the gauge.

# Snowdrop Mason Jar Cover

This jar cozy is a perfect way to add a touch of candle-lit warmth to any room. Be sure to use a battery-operated candle in the jar, to be extra safe!

Cozy measures 9" [23cm] wide x 8" [20.5 cm] long

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

**Sk2p:** Slip stitch knit wise, knit next two stitches together, pass slipped stitch over knit stitch. (2 stitches decreased.)

## NOTE

Cozy is worked from the top down.

## COZY

Cast on 40 stitches and divide evenly over 4 needles. Join being careful not to twist stitches and place stitch marker for beginning of round.

**Rounds 1-5:** \*K2, p2; repeat from \* around.

**Rounds 6-9:** \*P1, k3, p1; repeat from \* around.

**Round 10:** \*P1, yo, sk2p, yo, p1; repeat from \* around.

**Round 11:** Repeat Round 6.

Repeat Rounds 6-11 until piece measures 7" [18cm] from cast on.

**Next Round (Decrease):** \*K2tog, k2; repeat from \* around – 30 sts.

**Next Round:** Knit.

**Next Round (Decrease):** \*K2tog, k1; repeat from \* around – 20 sts.

**Next Round:** Knit.

**Next Round (Decrease):** \*K2tog around – 10 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a tail 12" [30.5cm] long. Draw through remaining stitches twice, fasten securely.

## Finishing

Weave in all ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**cm** = centimeters; **K** = knit; **K2tog** = knit 2 sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **P** = purl; **Sk2p** = slip, **k2 tog**, **psso** (see special abbreviation); **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yo** = yarn over needle; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.



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
