What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®:
2 skeins 3949 Reef

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 12 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 11 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pattern.
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given.

BUY YARN



RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); stripes, prints, multicolor and heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yd (215 m); and flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yd (238 m) skeins



Long & Twisted Cowl

This cowl is made with a twist, but it's still simple enough to work on when hanging out with friends. Loop it once or twice, either way you'll stay nice and warm!

Cowl measures 9" (23 cm) wide and 67" (170 cm) long before seaming.

NOTES

Cowl fabric is completely reversible. Cowl is crocheted from the bottom up before being twisted and seamed with the twist in place to create a "mobius" loop cowl. Turning chain (ch 1) counts as a single crochet in this pattern.

COWL

Ch 31.

Row 1 (Right Side): Dc in 3rd ch from hook [counts as (sc, dc)], *skip 1 ch, (sc, dc) in next ch; repeat from * to last 2 chs, skip 1 ch, sc in last ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, dc in first sc [counts as (sc, dc)], *skip next dc, (sc, dc) in next sc; repeat from * to last 2 sts, skip next dc, sc in last sc, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 67" (170 cm) from foundation edge. Do not fasten off.

Join Short Ends

Lay piece flat. Twist one short end to create a "mobius" twist, then bring two short ends together. Using working yarn, slip st across the short ends to secure the twist. Fasten off.

FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave in all loose ends.



ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **()** = work directions in parentheses into same st; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
