



SCARF

Ch 23.

Row 1: (2 tr, ch 1, dc) in 4th ch from hook; *skip next 3 ch, (2 tr, ch 1, dc) in next ch; repeat from * across to last 3 ch, skip next 2 ch, tr in last ch; turn – 5 shells.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 tr, ch 1, dc) in each ch-1 space across, skip next 2 tr, tr in beginning ch-3, turn. Repeat row 2 until scarf measures 60” long. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

For fringe, locate 6 spaces between clusters along beginning edge. Cut 3 strands of yarn, 24” long. Fold strands in half and pull through first space from front to back; bring cut ends through fold and tighten to form fringe. Repeat for other 5 spaces. Trim ends of fringe even. Repeat for other end of scarf.

RED HEART® “Curly Q™”: 3 balls 7958 Totally Teal

Crochet Hook: 9 mm [US M-13].
Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 10 sts and 4 rows = 4” in pattern st. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.
