



Finished Bust/Waist: 25 (28, 30)".

Finished Length: 50".

Stitch of Circle Wrap has a good amount of ease and measurements will change when worn.

RED HEART® "Soft Yarn": 1 Ball each 4422 Tangerine A, 9779 Berry B, 9528 Lilac C, 9520 Seafoam D and 4420 Guacamole E.

Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8].
Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 13 hdc = 4"; 16 ch = 4"; 4 rows = 4" using.
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Note: Circle Wrap is worked in rounds from center out.

CIRCLE WRAP

With A, ch 4, slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), work 7 dc in ring, slip st in top of beginning ch to join – 8 dc.

Round 2: [Ch 4, slip st in next 2 dc] around, slip st in first ch of beginning ch.

Round 3: [Slip st in ch-4 space, ch 6] around, slip st in first ch of beginning ch to join

Round 4: Ch 3, [work 5 dc in ch-6 space, dc in slip st] around to last ch-6 space, work 5 dc in ch-6 space, slip st in top of beginning ch – 24 dc.

Round 5: Ch 3, dc in same space, [2 dc in each dc] around, slip st in top of beginning ch – 48 dc.

Fasten off.

Round 6: Join B in any st, ch 11 (counts as dc and ch 8), [skip next 5 dc, dc in next dc, ch 8] around to last 5 dc, skip next 5 dc, slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch.

Round 7: Ch 3, dc in same space, [ch 8, 2 dc in next dc], around, ch 8, slip st in top of beginning ch.

Round 8: Ch 3, dc in next dc, [work 8 dc in ch-8 space, dc in next 2 dc, ch 8, dc in next 2 dc] around to last 2 ch-8 spaces, work 8 dc in ch-8 space, dc in next 2 dc, ch 8, slip st in beginning ch.

Round 9: Ch 3, dc in next 11 dc, [10 dc in next ch-8 space, dc in next 12 dc] around to last ch-8 space, 10 dc in next ch-8 space, slip st in beginning ch – 88 sts.

Fasten off.

Round 10: Join C in any st, ch 5 (counts as dc and ch 2), [dc in next dc, ch 2, skip next dc] around, slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch.

Create a playful fashion wrap that you can wear to fit the needs of your day or your mood. Wear it tied around your neck, around your waist as a sarong or around your shoulders as a cape.

INTERMEDIATE

Designed by Double Stitch.

Directions are for size Small; changes for sizes Medium and Large are in parentheses.

Round 11: Ch 15 (counts as dc and ch-12 here and throughout), [skip next 4 ch-2 spaces, dc in next dc, ch 12] around, skip last 4 ch-2 spaces, slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch – 11 ch-12 spaces.

Round 12: Ch 15, [dc in next dc, ch 12] around, slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch.

Round 13: Ch 13 (counts as dc and ch-10, [dc in ch-12 space, ch 10, dc in next dc, ch 10] around, slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch – 22 ch-10 spaces.

Round 14: (Ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same space for First Corner, [ch 10, dc in next dc] 4 times, ch 10, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next dc for Second Corner, [ch 10, dc in next dc] 16 times, ch 10, slip st in top of beginning ch.

Fasten off.

Round 15: Join **D** in ch-2-space of First Corner, (ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same space, [ch 12, dc in next dc] 4 times, ch 12, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 space for Second Corner, [ch 12, dc in next dc] 16 times, ch 12, slip st in top of beginning ch.

Rounds 16-19: Slip st to ch-2 space, (ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch-2 space, [ch 12 (14, 16), dc in next dc] 4 times, ch 12 (14, 16), (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 space, [ch 12 (14, 16), dc in next dc] 16 times, ch 12 (14, 16), slip st in top of beginning ch.

Fasten off.

Round 20: Join **E** in ch-2-space of First Corner, (ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same space, [ch 14 (16, 18), dc in next dc] 4 times, ch 14 (16, 18), (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 space for Second Corner, [ch 14 (16, 18), dc in next dc] 16 times, ch 14 (16, 18), slip st in top of beginning ch.

Rounds 21: Slip st to ch-2 space, (ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch-2 space, [ch 14 (16, 18), dc in next dc] 4 times, ch 14 (16, 18), (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 space, [ch 14 (16, 18), dc in next dc] 16 times, ch 14 (16, 18), slip st in top of beginning ch.

Rounds 22-23: Slip st to ch-2 space, (ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch-2 space, [ch 16 (18, 20), dc in next dc] 4 times, ch 16 (18, 20), (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 space, [ch 16 (18, 20), dc in next dc] 16 times, ch 16 (18, 20), slip st in top of beginning ch.

Round 24: Slip st to ch-2 space, (ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch-2 space, [ch 18 (20, 22), dc in next dc] 4 times, ch 18 (20, 22), (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 space, [ch 18 (20, 22), dc in next dc] 16 times, ch 18 (20, 22), slip st in top of beginning ch.

Fasten off.

Round 25: Join **D** in ch-2-space of First Corner, (ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same space, [ch 9 (10, 11), dc in ch-18 (20, 22) space, ch 9 (10, 11), dc in next dc] 4 times, ch 9 (10,

11), dc in ch-18 (20, 22) space, ch 9 (10, 11), (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 space for Second Corner, [ch 9 (10, 11), dc in ch-18 (20, 22) space, ch 9 (10, 11), dc in next dc] 16 times, ch 9 (10, 11), dc in ch-18 (20, 22) space, ch 9 (10, 11), slip st in top of beginning ch.

Fasten off.

Round 26: With **C**, repeat Round 25.

Fasten off.

Round 27: With **B**, repeat Round 25.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Tie

With **A**, ch 150 for Tie, slip st in ch-2 space of First Corner, slip st in each st across to ch-2 space of Second Corner, ch 150 for Tie.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
