



Textured Neck Warmer

This stretchy yarn is perfect to use for this cozy alternative to a scarf. Crocheting this will go very quickly since yarn is super bulky and there are only 12 rows.

EASY

Designed by Double Stitch Twins.

Neck Warmer measures 16" wide x 11" long, unbuttoned.

RED HEART® "Curly Q™": 1 Ball each 7931 Granite **A** and 7970 Mexicali **B**.

Crochet Hook: 10mm [US N-15].
2 buttons, 1½" diameter, yarn needle.

GAUGE: 7 tr = 4"; 3 rows = 4" using 2 strands of yarn held together. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

NECK WARMER

Holding 1 strand of **A** and **B** together throughout, ch 23.

Row 1: Tr in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across.

Rows 2 -12: Ch 3, (counts as a tr here and throughout), turn, tr in each st across – 20 sts.

Row 13: Ch 2, turn, dc in each tr across.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Sew 1 button, 1" from one side edge on Row 13. Sew second button 2" from first button. Buttons will be pushed through sts of Row 1.

ABBREVIATIONS: **A, B, C** = Color A, B, C; **ch** = chain;
dc = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es);
tr = triple or treble crochet.
