Easy Wrap Comfort Scarf

*Everyone loves the big slits in this scarf.
They allow you to slip the scarf end
through in a variety of ways.*

EASY

Designed by Double Stitch Twins.

Scarf measures 5½" wide x 74" long.

RED HEART® Boutique™ "Changes™": 4 Balls 9101 Cream.

Crochet Hook: 9mm [US M/N-13].

GAUGE: 7 sts = 4"; 6 rows = 4" in pattern st using 2 strands of yarn held together. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**
Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

SCARF

Holding 2 strands of yarn together throughout, ch 132
Row 1: Dc in 3rd ch from hook and each ch across – 130 sts.
Rows 2, 4 and 6: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), turn, hdc in next 12 dc, [ch 6, skip next 5 dc, hdc in next 6 dc] 9 times, ch 6, skip next 5 dc, hdc in last 13 dc.
Rows 3, 5 and 7: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, dc in next 12 hdc, [5 dc in next ch-6 space, dc in next 6 hdc] 9 times, 5 dc in next ch-6 space, dc in next 13 hdc.
Row 8: Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc across.
Fasten off.

Trim Row: With right side facing and working across opposite edge of foundation ch, join yarn in first st, ch 1, sc in each ch across.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Fringes

Cut 64 strands of yarn, each 22" long. Holding 4 strands together, fold lengths in half. With right side facing, insert hook from wrong side to right side along one short edge of Scarf and pull loop through. Pull ends through loop and pull to tighten. Work 32 fringes across each short edge. Trim ends evenly.

ABBREVIATIONS: ch = chain; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
