



Crochet Hook: 8mm [US L-11].
Yarn needle.

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.

NOTE: 1 strand of **A** and **B** are held together throughout.

SCARF

With 1 strand of **A** and **B** held together, ch 133.

Row 1: Dc in 3rd ch from hook and each ch across – 131 dc.

Rows 2-3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, Fpdc in each dc across.

Row 4: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, Fphdc in each dc across.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
