



## Mini Capelet

*Take an ordinary dress or tee to outright charming with this capelet that can be crocheted in little time. Wear it whatever the season for a chic accessory that isn't your usual necklace or scarf.*

Designed by Double Stitch Twins.

**One size fits most.**

**Capelet measures 7" long.**

**RED HEART® Shimmer™:** 1 Ball 1536 Purple.

**Crochet Hook:** 5mm [US H-8].

Yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 11 dc = 4"; 8 rows = 4". **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

### CAPELET

Ch 46.

**Row 1:** Hdc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch.

**Rows 2-3:** Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), turn, hdc in each hdc across across – 45 sts.

**Row 4:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, 2 dc in next hdc, [ch 1, skip next hdc, 2 dc in next hdc] across to last st, dc in last st.

**Row 5:** Ch 3, turn, dc in each dc and ch-1 space across – 67 dc.

**Row 6:** Ch 3, turn, dc in each dc across.

**Row 7:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next 4 dc, 2 dc in next dc, [dc in next 5 dc, 2 dc in next dc] across to last st, dc in last st – 78 dc.

**Row 8:** Ch 4 (counts as tr here and throughout), turn, tr in next 4 dc, 2 tr in next dc, [tr in next 5 dc, 2 tr in next dc] across – 91 tr.

**Row 9:** Ch 4, turn, tr in next 2 tr, [ch 2, skip next tr, tr in next 3 tr] across.

**Row 10:** Ch 12 (counts as tr and ch 8), turn, 2 tr in next ch-2 space, [ch 8, 2 tr in next ch-2 space] across to last 3 tr, tr in last 3 tr.

**Row 11:** Ch 4, turn, tr in next 2 tr, [8 tr in next ch-8 space, tr in next 2 tr] across to last ch-8 space, 8 tr in last ch-8 space. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

#### Edging and Ties

Ch 50, with right side facing, join yarn opposite foundation ch, sc in each ch across, ch 50.

Fasten off. Weave in ends.
