### What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:**  
2 skeins each 505 Aruba Sea **A**,  
668 Honeydew 661 Frosty Green **B**,  
and 656 Real Teal **C** and 400  
Grey Heather **D**

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
5.5 mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** Hexagon measures 6"  
[15 cm] across. **CHECK YOUR  
GAUGE.** Use any size hook to  
obtain the gauge.

**RED HEART® Super  
Saver®**, Art. E300

## Flower Throw

*The perfect carry-along project, this easy  
throw is made in individual motifs.*

*It's a great project for those stolen moments  
when you're waiting for a child's activities or an  
appointment. Just stick the yarn and your hook in  
your bag and you're ready to go!*

**Throw measures 57" [145 cm] x 48"  
[122 cm].**

### Special Abbreviation

**dec (decrease)** = draw up a loop in next 2  
sts, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops.

### THROW

Hexagon (Make 21 each with **A** and **B**; and  
20 each with **C** and **D**)

**Round 1:** Ch 4; join with slip st in first ch to  
form a ring; ch 1, 12 sc in ring; join with slip  
st in first sc.

**Round 2:** [Ch 3, slip st in next sc] 12 times.

**Round 3:** (Slip st, ch 1, sc) in next ch-3  
space, \* ch 5, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 1 \*\*,  
sc in next ch-3 space; repeat from \* around,  
end at \*\*; join in first sc.

**Round 4:** [(Sc, hdc, dc, tr, ch 1, tr, dc, hdc,  
sc) all in next ch-5 space, slip st in next ch-1  
space] 6 times.

**Round 5:** Ch 7, \* (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch-1  
space between next 2 tr, ch 3 \*\*, working  
over the slip st of Round 4, tr in next ch-1  
space of Round 3, ch 3; repeat from \*  
around, end at \*\*; join with slip st in 4th ch  
of ch-7.

**Round 6:** Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, \* 3 sc  
in next ch-3 space, 3 sc in next ch-2 space, 3  
sc in next ch-3 space \*\*, sc in next tr; repeat  
from \* around, end at \*\*; join. Fasten off.

### COLOR PATTERN

**Row 1:** A,B,C,D,A,B,C

**Row 2:** B,C,D,A,B,C,D,A

**Row 3:** D,A,B,C,D,A,B

**Row 4:** A,B,C,D,A,B,C,D

**Row 5:** C,D,A,B,C,D,A

**Row 6:** D,A,B,C,D,A,B,C

**Row 7:** B,C,D,A,B,C,D

**Row 8:** C,D,A,B,C,D,A,B

**Row 9:** A,B,C,D,A,B,C

**Row 10:** B,C,D,A,B,C,D,A

**Row 11:** D,A,B,C,D,A,B

### ASSEMBLY

With right sides together, whip stitch  
hexagons together through back loops only  
into alternating rows of 7 and 8 hexagons,  
following color pattern above. Then whip  
stitch strips together in order, starting at top  
with Row 1 and ending at bottom with  
Row 11.

### BORDER

With right side facing, join **B** in back loop  
of any sc; ch 1, working in back loops only,  
sc around entire throw working 3 sc in  
center sc of 3-sc groups at outer points and  
work dec at inner points over last sc of one  
hexagon and first sc of next hexagon; join.  
Fasten off. Weave in ends.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C, D** = color A, B, C, D; **ch** = chain; **dc** =  
double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet;  
**mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)**  
= stitch (es); **tr** = treble crochet; **yo** = yarn  
over; \* **or** \*\* = repeat whatever follows the  
\* or \*\* as indicated; [ ] = work directions in  
brackets the number of times specified.


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ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM



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
