What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Treasure™:
3 balls 1923 Tapestry

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
6.5mm [US K-101/2]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 13 pattern sts = 4"
[10cm]; 8 pattern rows = 4"
[10cm]. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use
any size hook to obtain the gauge
given.

Desert Arrow Scarf

This mitered design is perfect for showing off the beautiful shadings in the yarn. No one but you will know how easy it was to crochet this gorgeous scarf! It's perfect for an impressive gift.

Scarf measures 7½" x 60" (19cm x 152)

NOTES

1. All dc will be "pushed" to the wrong side of the row.
2. Do not work into the last stitch of rows. Ch-3 turns counts as first dc.

SCARF

Ch 31.

Row 1 (Right Side): Slip st in 4th ch from hook, *dc in next ch, slip st in next ch*, repeat from * to * 5 times, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch, **slip st in next ch, dc in next ch**, repeat from ** to ** 6 times. Ch 1, turn.

Rows 2–127: Slip st in next sl st, ch 3, slip st in next dc, *dc in next slip st, sl st in next dc*, repeat from * to * 5 times, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 space, **slip st in next dc, dc in next slip st**, repeat from * to * 6 times. Ch 1, turn.

Row 128: Slip st in next dc, ch 3, *slip st in next dc, dc in next slip st*, repeat from * to * 5 times, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 space, **slip st in next dc, dc in next slip st**, repeat from ** to ** 6 times. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; sl st = slip stitch; st(s) = stitch(es); yo = yarn over; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
