What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 4 balls 4601 Off White A, 2 balls 9520 Seafoam B and 1 ball each of 9870 Deep Sea C, 2515 Turquoise D and 9518 Teal E.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6.5 mm [US K-10½]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Square motif = 2½" (6.5 cm) across. Octagon motif = 6" (15 cm) across. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needle to obtain the gauge given.



RED HEART® Soft®, Art. E728 available in solid color 5 oz (141 g), 256 yd (234 m), multi 4 oz (113 g), 204 yd (187 m), and heather 4oz (113g), 212 yd (194m) balls



Mosaic Throw

This beautiful throw reminds us of elegant mosaic or tile work. Crochet it in shades of turquoise, as we show it, or choose your own colors for a unique throw that's a reflection of you!

Throw measures 32" x 49" (81.5 x 124.5 cm)

THROW

Square Motif (make 38)

With A, ch 4, join with a slip st to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), 11 dc in ring; join with slip st in top of beg ch-3 – 12 dc.

Round 2: Ch 3, dc in first st, 2 dc in each dc around; join with slip st in top of beg ch-3 – 24 dc.

Round 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, *3 dc in next st, hdc in next st**, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next st; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **, sc in next st; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

Octagon Motif

(Make 39: working 24 with A for 2nd color, 5 each with C, D, and E for 2nd color)

With B, ch 4, join with a slip st to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), 15 dc in ring; join with slip st in top of beg ch-3 – 16 dc.

Round 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in first st, dc in next dc, *3 dc in next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beg ch-3 – 32 dc.

Round 3: Ch 3, *3 dc in next dc**, dc in each of next 3 dc; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **, dc in last 2 dc; change to 2nd color, with 2nd color join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-3 – 48 dc. Fasten off B.

Round 4: With 2nd color, ch 3, dc in next dc, *3 dc in next dc**, dc in each of next 5 dc; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **, dc in each of last 3 dc; join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-3 – 64 dc.

Round 5: Ch 3, dc in next dc, *3 dc in next dc**, dc in each of next 7 dc; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **, dc in each of last 4 dc; join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-3 – 80 dc. Fasten off 2nd color.

FINISHING

With A, sew motifs together following Assembly Diagram on next page.

Border

With right side facing, join A with a slip st along any st on outside edge, ch 3, dc in each dc around, working 3 dc in each outside corner; join with a slip st in beginning ch-3. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C, D, E = color A, B, C, D, E; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch (es); () = work directions in parentheses into same st; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.

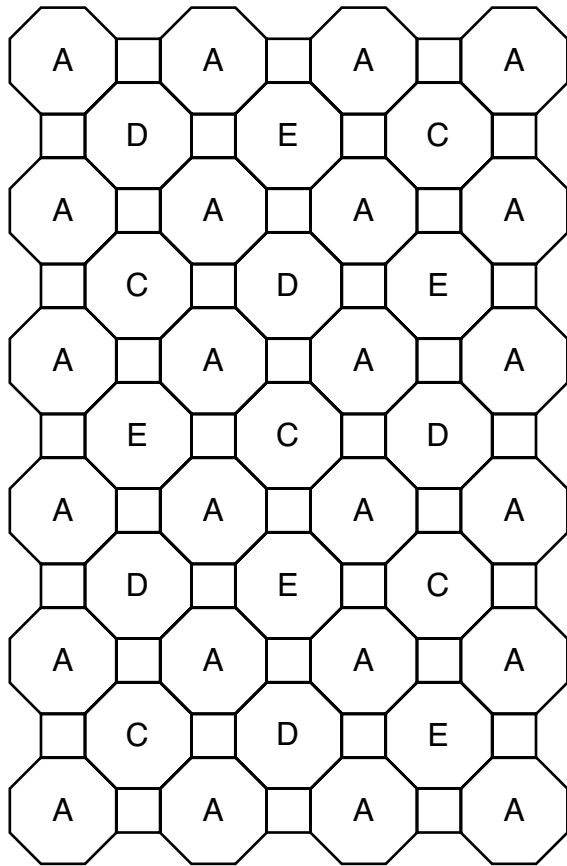
