### What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:**  
1 skein each 387 Soft Navy A, 656 Real Teal B, 400 Grey Heather C and 334 Buff D

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
4mm [US G-6]

Yarn needle, rustproof T-pins, 12" (30.5 cm) foam wreath, tacky glue

**GAUGE:** 4 sts = 1" (2.25 cm).  
**CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain gauge.

## Argyle for Dad Wreath

*Honor a special Dad with a crochet wreath on your front door, or perhaps in his office window. The faux argyle is simply made by wrapping yarn around the crocheted diamond shapes. Then necktie and collar are added for the perfect June wreath!*

### NOTE

For easier wrapping, make a 5" (12.8 cm) ball of A to wrap around wreath.

### WREATH

With **A**, tie a knot around the wreath where the foam joins to prevent a bump. Start wrapping the yarn around the wreath, making sure there are no gaps.

Wreath can be held between the knees for faster wrapping.

After every few wraps tighten and twist the yarn on the wreath. When wreath is fully covered, tie the end in a knot and secure by weaving under wraps.



### Diamond (Make 9 each in B and C)

Ch 2.

**Row 1:** 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first sc), turn—4 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1 (counts as first sc here and throughout), sc in first sc (increase made), sc in next 2 sc, turn—4 sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in next 2 sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—5 sc.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in next 3 sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—6 sc.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in next 4 sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—7 sc.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in next 5 sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—8 sc.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in next 6 sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—9 sc.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next 6 sc, skip next sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—8 sc.

**Row 9:** Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next 5 sc, skip next sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—7 sc.

**Row 10:** Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next 4 sc, skip next sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—6 sc.

**Row 11:** Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next 3 sc, skip next sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—5 sc.

**Row 12:** Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next 2 sc, skip next sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—4 sc.

**Row 13:** Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in sc, skip next sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—3 sc.

**Row 14:** Ch 1, skip first 2 sc, slip st in top of beginning ch—1 sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Shape edges of diamonds with your fingers. Alternating colors, place the diamonds on the Wreath, making sure side points are touching each other. Once they are in place, glue each diamond to the wreath. Let dry.



### Wrapping for the Argyle Look

Tie a knot with **D**, and insert a T-pin through the knot and into the back of the wreath.

Skipping **C** diamonds, wrap yarn across each

**Please Note:** Print this pattern using Landscape Orientation.

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**B** diamond diagonally around. Working in the same direction, skipping **B** diamonds, wrap yarn across each **C** diamond diagonally around. Wrap the yarn twice around the T-pin to tighten and hold the yarn in place. Working in opposite direction, skipping **B** diamonds, wrap yarn across each **C** diamond diagonally around. Working in the same direction, skipping **C** diamonds, wrap yarn across each **B** diamond diagonally around. Each diamond should have an "X." When finished, tie end of yarn in a knot, and insert a T-pin through the knot and into the back of the wreath. Hide ends.



## Tie

With **A**, ch 2.

**Rows 1–7:** Repeat Rows 1–7 of Diamond.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next 7 sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—9 sc.

**Rows 9–15:** Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next 7 sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—9 sc.

**Row 16:** Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next 6 sc, skip next sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—8 sc.

**Row 17:** Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next 5 sc, skip next sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—7 sc.

**Row 18:** Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next 4 sc, skip next sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—6 sc.

**Row 19:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 4 sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—8 sc.

**Row 20:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 6 sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—10 sc.

**Row 21:** Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next 8 sc, slip st in top of beginning ch—9 sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.



## Collar (Make 2)

With **C**, ch 2.

**Rows 1–7:** Repeat rows 1–7 of Diamond.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in next 7 sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—10 sc.

**Row 9:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in next 8 sc, sc in top of beginning ch, turn—11 sc.

Ch 20, fasten off.

With a tail of color **C**, sew the beginning of row 9 to the top of the Tie, so you'll have 1 Collar on each side of Tie. Position Collar chains from 5 Diamonds apart and pin ends to back of Wreath. Hide ends.

## Hanger

Cut 14" (35.5 cm) of each **B**, **C** and **D** yarn. Braid yarn. Position ends 3 Diamonds apart, and attach to the top of foam wreath with T-pins.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C, D** = Color A, B, C, D; **ch** = chain; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es).



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
