What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®, 1 skein each of 1623 Mallard A, 1012 Black B, 1909 Holly Berry C, and 1303 Aran D.

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles: 4 mm [US 6]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 20 sts = 4" (10 cm); 24 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Stockinette Stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

RED HEART® With Love®, Art. E400 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 370 yd (338 m) and multicolor 5 oz (141 g), 230 yd (211 m) skeins



Best Guy Sweater Ornament

Knit a sweater for the tree! This handsome sweater has a manly look and is a nice gift for a special guy. Great for attaching to gifts of food...or maybe a gift of yarn to a male knitter.

Finished Size: 4" (10 cm) long

ORNAMENT

Body (Make 2)

With A, cast on 20 sts.

Row 1 (Right side): (K1, P1) across.

Rows 2-4: (K1, P1) across.

Row 5: Knit across, drop A.

Row 6: With B, purl across.

Row 7: Knit across.

Row 8: Purl across, drop B.

Row 9: With C, knit across.

Row 10: Purl across, drop C.

Row 11: With D, knit across.

Row 12: Purl across.

Rows 13-20: Repeat Rows 11 and 12.

Row 21: Bind off 4 sts, knit across: 16 sts.

Row 22: Bind off 4 sts, purl across: 12 sts.

Rows 23-29: (K1, P1) across.

Bind off all sts in pattern. Sew sides together at neck and shoulders.

Sleeves (Make 2)

With A, cast on 12 sts.

Row 1 (Right side): (K1, P1) across.

Rows 2-4: (K1, P1) across.

Row 5: Knit across, drop A.

Row 6: With B, purl across.

Row 7: Knit across.

Row 8: Purl across, drop B.

Row 9: With C, knit across.

Row 10: Purl across, drop C.

Row 11: With D, knit across.

Row 12: Purl across.

Rows 13-16: Repeat Rows 11 and 12.

Bind off all sts in knit.

FINISHING

Thread yarn needle with a length of A. With right sides together and using photo as a guide, sew Sleeves to sleeve openings, sleeve seam, and side seams.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm = centimeter; K = knit; mm = millimeter; P = purl; st(s) = stitch(es); () = follow instructions in parentheses as indicated.
