### What you will need:

RED HEART® Kids™: 6 skeins  
2940 Beach

Susan Bates® Crochet hook:  
5mm [H-8]

Six - 1" (25.4 mm) white buttons,  
½" (12.7 mm) x 24" (61 cm) dowel  
rod

Gauge: 3 groups of 3 sts = 2½"  
(6.4 cm); 6 rows in pattern st =  
2¼" (5.7 cm)

## Toy Pocket Wall Hanging

*This organizing wall hanging is perfect for storing special toys in toddlers' view while keeping clutter at bay. Crochet it in a color to coordinate with child's room and hang it on a wall where toys will be easy to reach and put away.*

**Finished Measurements:** 18" x 27"  
(45.7 x 68.6 cm), excluding hanging tabs

### WALL HANGING

#### Back

Ch 65.

**Row 1:** Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—63 dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), Fpdc around each of next 2 dc, \*Bpdc around each of next 3 dc, Fpdc around each of next 3 dc, repeat from \* across, turn.

**Rows 3–64:** Repeat Row 2.

**Rows 65–67:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn—63 sc.

**Row 68:** Ch 1, sc in next 31 sc, sc decrease in next 2 sc, sc in each remaining sc, turn—62 sc. Do not fasten off.

#### Tabs

##### First Tab

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in next 7 sc, leaving remaining sts unworked, turn—7 sc.

**Rows 2–12:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Row 13:** Ch 1, sc in next 2 sc, ch 1, skip next 3 sc (buttonhole), sc in last 2 sc, turn—4 sc, 1 ch-1 space.

**Row 14:** Ch 1, sc in next sc, draw up loop in next sc, ch-1 space and in next sc, yo, draw through all loops on hook, sc in last sc. Fasten off.

##### Tabs 2–5

**Row 1:** Skip next 4 sc on row 68, join yarn with sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc, leaving remaining sts unworked, turn—7 sc.

**Rows 2–14:** Repeat rows 2–14 of First Tab.

##### Tab 6

**Row 1:** Skip next 4 sc on row 68, join yarn with sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc, leaving remaining sts unworked, turn—7 sc.

**Rows 2–13:** Repeat rows 2–13 of First Tab.

**Row 14:** Ch 1, sc in next sc, draw up loop in next sc, ch-1 space and in next sc, yo, draw through all loops on hook, sc in last sc. Do not fasten off.

#### Edging

Sc in each st and in end of each row around, working 3 sc in each corner, join with slip st in first sc.

### FINISHING

Sew buttons in place between rows 67 & 68, adjacent to buttonholes.

### POCKETS (Make 5)

#### Top Ribbing

Ch 9.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—8 sc.

**Rows 2–63:** Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in each sc across, turn. Do not fasten off at end of last row.

#### Body

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in end of each ribbing row across, turn—63 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, dc in each sc across, turn.

**Rows 3–22:** Repeat row 2 of Back.

**Row 23:** Ch 1, sc in each st across. Fasten off.

#### Border

Join yarn with sc at top left corner of Pocket, sc in each st and in end of each row around to top right corner of Pocket, working 3 sc in each bottom corner. Fasten off.

#### Assembly

Pin 1 Pocket in place across bottom of Back as shown in photo. Carefully sew in place.

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Pin remaining Pocket in place 4" (10 cm) above bottom Pocket. Carefully sew in place making sure bottom of Pocket is straight.

**bpd**c = back post double crochet; **ch** = chain;  
**cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet;  
**fpdc** = front post double crochet; **mm** =  
millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **sl st** = slip  
stitch; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yo** = yarn over; [ ]  
= work directions in brackets the number of  
times specified; \* **or** \*\* = repeat whatever  
follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
