What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Midnight®:
8 balls 1951 Tropical

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
6mm [J-10 US]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 1 Square is 5" x 5" (12.5 x 12.5 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Crocheted Mitered Square Shawl

The wonderful shadings of the stunning yarn is shown to full potential in this shawl. As you crochet each new square, you work into the previous square so there are no seams. You'll love how nicely the L-shape design looks with the point covering your back.

Shawl measures 15" wide x 50" across longer edge (38 x 127 cm)

Special Stitches

Note: Insert hook in front loop only of sc.

sc3togC1 (single crochet corner decrease 1) = Insert hook in next st, pull up a loop, skip next st, insert hook in next st, pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yo and pull through all 3 loops. Note "Next st" may be sc or ch.

sc3togC2 (single crochet corner decrease 2) = Insert hook in next sc, pull up a loop, insert hook from front to back and to front again around st 1 row below next st, pull up a long loop, skip the st in the current row behind the loop just made, insert hook in next sc of current row, pull up a loop (4 loops on hook), yo and pull through all 4 loops.

Notes

1. L-shaped shawl is made from 51 square motifs worked in 10 joined sections.
2. Each square is worked off the preceding square beginning with a foundation row. Refer to diagram for placement.
3. Single crochet is worked in front loops only, except where instructed otherwise.
4. Mitered corners are worked over 3 stitches at center of each row.
5. Vary the color patterns by starting some balls from the inside tail and some from the outside.

SHAWL

Square 1

Ch 36.

Note Single crochet is worked in front loops only, except where instructed otherwise.

Row 1 (wrong side): Working in back bars, sc in 2nd ch from hook and next 15 ch, sc3togC1, sc in remaining 16 ch, turn—33 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first 15 sc, sc3togC2, sc in next 14 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—31 sts.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first 14 sc, sc3togC1, sc in next 13 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—29 sts.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 13 sc, sc3togC2, sc in next 12 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—27 sts.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first 12 sc, sc3togC1, sc in next 11 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—25 sts.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first 11 sc, sc3togC2, sc in next 10 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—23 sts.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first 10 sc, sc3togC1, sc in next 9 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—21 sts.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sc, sc3togC2, sc in next 8 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—19 sts.

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in first 8 sc, sc3togC1, sc in next 7 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—17 sts.

Row 10: Ch 1, sc in first 7 sc, sc3togC2, sc in next 6 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—15 sts.

Row 11: Ch 1, sc in first 6 sc, sc3togC1, sc in next 5 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—13 sts.

Row 12: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sc, sc3togC2, sc in next 4 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—11 sts.

Row 13: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc, sc3togC1, sc in next 3 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—9 sts.

Row 14: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sc, sc3togC2, sc in next 2 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—7 sts.

Row 15: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, sc3togC1, sc in next 1 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—5 sts.

Continued...



Please Note: Print this pattern using Landscape Orientation.

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Row 16: Ch 1, sc in first 1 sc, sc3togC2, sc in last sc, turn—3 sts.

Row 17: Working in front loop only, insert hook in next st, pull up a loop, skip next st, working in both loops, insert hook in next st, pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yo and pull through all 3 loops, turn—1 st. Do not fasten off.

Squares 2–10

Foundation Row (right side): Ch 1, sc in last st of Row 17 of previous square, working across ends of rows, work 16 sc evenly across side of previous square, ch 19, turn—17 sc and 19 ch.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 15 ch, sc3togC1, sc in next 15 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—33 sts.

Rows 2–17: Repeat Rows 2–17 of Square 1. Fasten off at end of Square 10.

Square 11

Ch 18.

Foundation Row (right side): With right side facing, insert hook in first square of previous row of squares; working across ends of rows, work 17 sc evenly across first square, turn—17 sc and 18 ch.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in first 16 sc, sc3togC1, working in back bars, sc in remaining ch, turn—33 sts.

Row 2–17: Repeat Rows 2–17 of square 1.

Squares 12–20

Foundation Row: Ch 1, sc in last st of Row 17 of previous square, working across ends of rows, work 16 sc evenly across side of previous square; working in both loops, sc in last st of square directly below previous square; working across ends of rows, work 17 sc evenly across next square, turn—35 sc.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in first 16 sc, sc3togC1, sc in next 15 sc, working in both loops, sc in last sc, turn—33 sts.

Row 2–17: Repeat Rows 2–17 of square 1. Fasten off at end of square 20.

Square 21–30

Repeat square 11 once, then repeat square 12 nine times. Fasten off at end of square 30.

Square 31

Ch 18.

Foundation Row (right side): With right side facing, insert hook in 8th square of previous row of squares; working across ends of rows, work 17 sc evenly across 8th square, turn—17 sc and 18 ch.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in first 16 sc, sc3togC1, working in back bars, sc in remaining ch, turn—33 sts.

Row 2–17: Repeat Rows 2–17 of square 1.

Squares 32 and 33

Repeat square 12 twice. Fasten off at end of square 33.

Squares 34–36

Repeat square 11 once, then repeat square 12 twice. Fasten off at end of square 36.

Squares 37–39

Repeat square 11 once, then repeat square 12 twice. Fasten off at end of square 39.

Squares 40–42

Repeat square 11 once, then repeat square 12 twice. Fasten off at end of square 42.

Squares 43–45

Repeat square 11 once, then repeat square 12 twice. Fasten off at end of square 45.

Squares 46–48

Repeat square 11 once, then repeat square 12 twice. Fasten off at end of square 48.

Squares 49–51

Repeat square 11 once, then repeat square 12 twice. Fasten off at end of square 51.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
