What you will need:

RED HEART® Heart & Sole®:
1 ball 3931 Berry Bliss

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
3.25mm [US D-3]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 24 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pattern stitch.
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Tie Bookmark

Need a suitable gift for the man who enjoys reading? This tie bookmark is perfect! It can be crocheted quickly with self-striping yarn and when he uses it he'll be reminded of your thoughtfulness.

Bookmark measures 1¾" [5 cm] wide x 6" [15 cm] high

NOTES

Fabric stiffener may be used for a stiffer bookmark.
Tie will be sandwiched between top of tie. Top will be stitched together wrong sides facing each other.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

dc2tog: [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yarn over, draw through all loops on hook

TIE

Ch 2.

Row 1: Work 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook – 4 sts.

Row 2: (Right Side) Ch 1, turn, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next 2 sc, sc in next sc – 6 sts.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc – 8 sts.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc – 10 sts.

Row 6: Repeat Row 3.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc – 12 sts.

Rows 8-9: Repeat Row 3.

Rows 10-11: Ch 3 (counts as a dc here and throughout), turn, dc in each st across.

Rows 12-14: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Rows 15-16: Repeat Rows 10-11.

Rows 17-19: Repeat Rows 12-14.

Row 20: Ch 3, turn, dc2tog; dc in next 6 sts, dc2tog, dc in last st – 10 sts.

Row 21: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Rows 22-24: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 25: Ch 3, turn, dc2tog, dc in next 4 sts, dc2tog, dc in last st – 8 sts.

Rows 26-30: Repeat Row 21.
Fasten off.

TOP

(Make 2)

Ch 9.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – 8 sts.

Row 2 (Right side): Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc – 10 sts.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across – 10 sts.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc – 12 sts.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

With right side facing, sew first row of one Top piece to last row of Tie. With wrong sides together and lining up edges, sew remaining Top piece to opposite side of first Top piece and Tie.

Sew running sts back and forth along join of Top and Tie, pulling to gather slightly to give knotted appearance.

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

ch = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
