What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby™: 2 balls of
10 Coconut

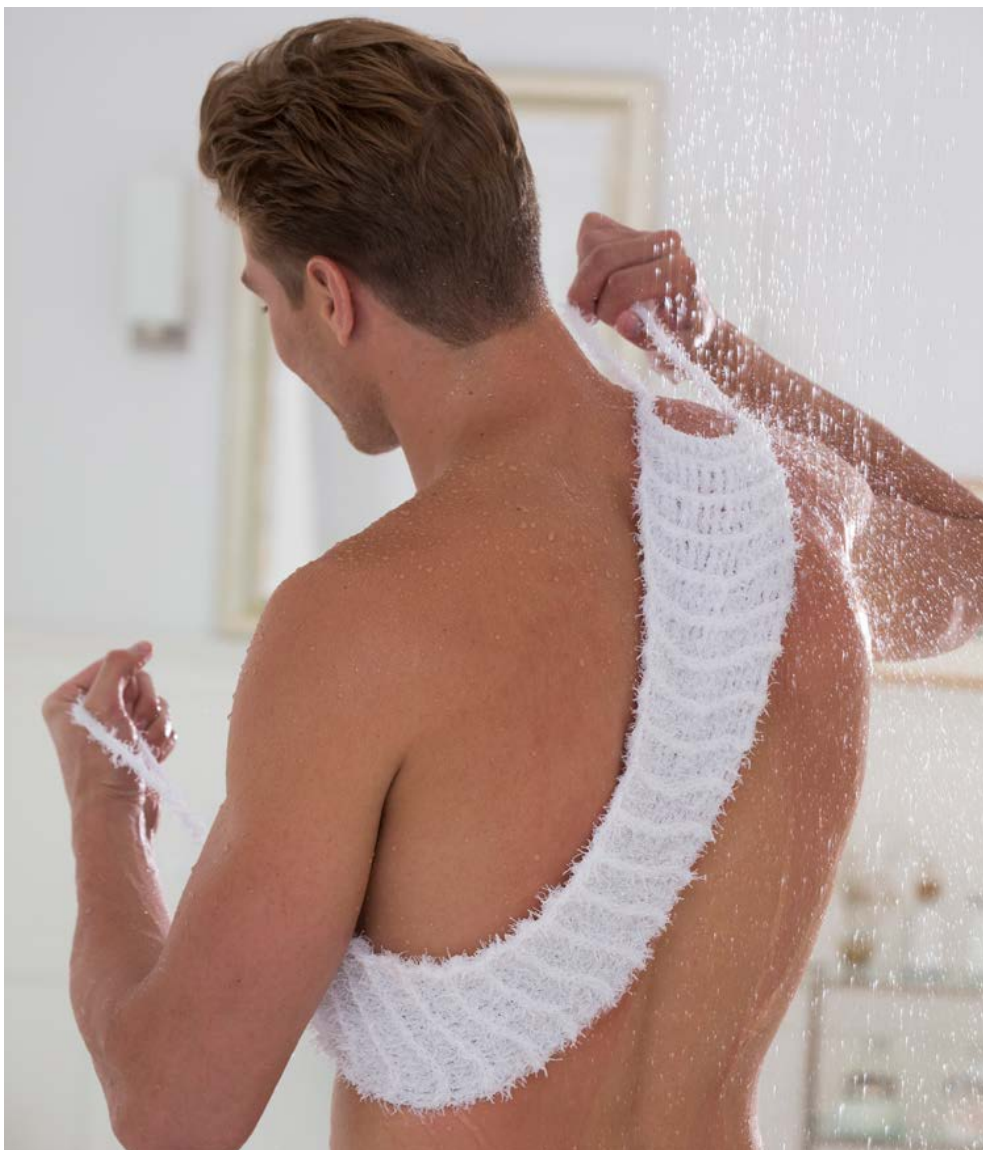
Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
5mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 14 sts = 4" (10 cm);
9 rows = 4" (10 cm) in double
crochet (dc). **CHECK YOUR
GAUGE. Use any size hook to
obtain the gauge.**

Back Scrubber

Here's a gift to crochet for the person who wishes they were at a spa. The ingenious yarn is great at cleaning without being rough on your skin. It washes easily by machine for cleanliness and reuse-ability.

SHOP KIT

Back Scrubber measures 5½ x 22" (14 x 56 cm), not including handles.

Special Stitch

Fpdc (Front post double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook from front side of work to back and to front again around post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (1 loop remains on hook).

BACK SCRUBBER

Ch 22.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as first dc) and in each remaining ch across, turn—20 dc.

Rows 2–48: Ch 3 (counts as dc), Fpdc around next 18 dc, dc in top of turning ch, turn.

First Handle: Ch 35, skip first 19 sts of Row 48, slip st in last st, turn, sc in each ch across, slip st in beginning of Row 48. Fasten off.

Second Handle: Join yarn with slip st in corner of short end of scratcher that does not yet have a handle, ch 35, slip st in other corner of short end of scratcher, turn, sc in each ch across, slip st near joining slip st. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es).



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
