## knitting

### What you will need:

**RED HEART® With Love®:** 1 skein  
1938 Beachy

**Susan Bates® Knitting Needles:**  
5.5mm [US 9]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 15 sts = 4" (10 cm); 20 rows = 4" (10 cm) in pattern.  
**CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

### Buy Yarn



**RED HEART® With Love®,** Art. E400 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 390 yd (357 m) and multicolor 5 oz (141 g), 230 yd (211 m) skeins.



## Drop Stitch Cowl

*Knit this cowl with a drop stitch pattern that is easy to master and lets the cowl drape beautifully. The repeated pattern shows the multicolored yarn to great advantage.*

**Cowl measures 12" (30.5 cm) wide and 24" (61 cm) around.**

### Notes

1. Piece is worked back and forth in rows then short edges are sewn together to form cowl.
2. Gauge is not critical. It can be a bit difficult to exactly measure gauge given the nature of the double yarn over stitches.

### COWL

Cast on 45 sts.

**Rows 1–6:** Knit.

**Row 7 (right side):** K2, [yarn over] twice, \*k1, [yarn over] twice; repeat from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 8 (wrong side):** K2, drop the next 2 yarn overs from the left needle, \*k1, drop the next 2 yarn overs from the left needle; repeat from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

Repeat Rows 1–8 until piece measures about 24" (61 cm), ending with a Row 8.

Bind off all sts as if to knit.

### FINISHING

Sew short ends together. Weave in ends.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**k** = knit; **st(s)** = stitch(es); \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
