### What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:**  
2 skeins 3942 Lagoon

**Susan Bates® knitting needles:**  
9mm [US 13]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 11 sts = 4" (10 cm); 17 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Slip Stitch pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); multicolor, heather and print 5 oz (141 g), 236 yd (215 m), flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



# Warm Colorful Cowl

*Choose a beautiful shade of multi-color yarn and relax while you knit this easy cowl! It's perfect for a quick project to brighten your look or for gift giving.*

**Cowl measures 11" (28 cm) wide and 32" (81 cm) long before seaming.**

## PATTERN STITCHES

**Slip Stitch Pattern (multiple of 2 sts + 1)**

**Row 1 (wrong side):** K1, purl to last st, K1.

**Row 2:** K1, \*slip 1 st wyib, K1; repeat from \* to end of row. Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for pattern.

## COWL

Holding two strands of yarn together, loosely cast on 31 sts. Work Slip Stitch Pattern until piece measures 32" (81 cm), ending with Row 1. Bind off all sts loosely.

## FINISHING

With yarn needle, sew cast on edge to bind off edge. Weave in all loose ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**K** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **P** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **wyib** = with yarn in back; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
