What you will need:

RED HEART® Mixology Prints™:
1 ball 931 Sizzling Print A
RED HEART® Mixology Solids™:
1 ball each 263 Coral B and 703 Pink D
RED HEART® Mixology Swirl™:
1 ball 9931 Sizzling C

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles:
12mm [US 17]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 7 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 10 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stitch Pattern.
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

Multi-Textured Cowl

Let your creativity go wild as you choose from Mixology Solids, Prints and textural Swirl, all in artisan color combinations. This easy-knit cowl uses 4 balls in shades of pink and coral, but would be equally as smashing in any of the other Mixology color ranges.

Cowl Measures 9" wide x 30" circumference [23 cm x 76 cm]

SPECIAL STITCHES

K2TOG = Knit 2 sts together.

YO = Yarn over needle.

STITCH PATTERN

Rows 1 and 3 (Right Side): Knit.

Rows 2 and 4 (Wrong Side): Purl.

Rows 5 and 9 (Right Side): Purl.

Rows 6 and 8 (Wrong Side): Knit.

Row 7 (Right Side): *YO, k2tog; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 10 (Wrong Side): Purl.

Repeat Rows 1–10 for Stitch Pattern.

NOTE

Knit first and last stitch on every row and work center 14 sts in Stitch Pattern.

COWL

With **A**, cast on 16 sts.

First Row (Wrong Side): K1, P14, K1.

Begin working Row 1 (Right Side) of Stitch Pattern keeping first and last st in knit, and center 14 sts in Stitch Pattern. Continue until 1 repeat (Rows 1-10) have been completed. Cut **A**.

Next Rows: Change to **B** and work Rows 1-10 of Stitch Pattern. Cut **B**.

Next Rows: Change to **C** and work Rows 1-10 of Stitch Pattern. Cut **C**.

Next Rows: Change to **D** and work Rows 1-10 of Stitch Pattern. Cut **D**.

Repeat Rows 1-10 in **A-D** one more time.

There will be 2 repeats of each color **A, B, C, D, A, B, C, D** — 8 stripes total. Bind off all sts knitwise on Row 10 of second stripe of **D**.

FINISHING

With yarn needle, sew cast on row to bind off row, forming a circle. Weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm = centimeters; **K** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **P** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **St st** = Stockinette stitch; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
