### What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:**  
1 skein each 319 Cherry Red **A**,  
316 Soft White **B**, and 385 Royal **C**

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
5mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle, stitch marker

**GAUGE:** 10 sc = 3" (10 cm); 7  
rows = 4" (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR  
GAUGE.** Use any size hook to  
obtain the gauge.

## Patriotic Stripes Bottle Cozy

*Reflect your love of country with bottle cozies  
featuring colors of red, white and blue. They're  
perfect for treating your guests to stylish drinks—  
and can be easily washed and reused anytime!*

**Cozy measures 4" (10 cm) wide x 8" long  
(20.5 cm), measured flat.**

### Special Stitch

**sc2tog** = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn  
over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over  
and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

### Note

To change color, work last stitch of old  
color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new  
color and draw through all loops on hook  
to complete stitch. Proceed with new color.  
Carry color not in use along wrong side  
until next needed.

## COZY

### Body

With **A**, ch 17.

**Row 1 (right side):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook  
and in each ch across, turn—16 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across; change to  
**B**, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc  
in each st across, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in each st across; change to  
**A**, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc  
in each st across, turn.

**Rows 6–25:** Repeat Rows 2–5 five times.

**Rows 26–28:** Repeat Rows 2–4; do not  
change color at end of last row.

Cut **A**. Fasten off **B** leaving a long tail for  
sewing. Sew first and last rows together.

### Neck

**Round 1 (right side):** With right side of  
either edge facing, join **C** with slip st in seam,  
ch 1, working in ends of rows, sc in each row  
around—28 sc. Do not join. Place marker for  
beginning of round and move marker up as  
each round is completed.

**Round 2:** \*Sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog: repeat  
from \* around—21 sc.

**Round 3:** \*Sc in next sc, sc2tog: repeat from \*  
around—14 sc.

**Round 4:** [Sc2tog] 7 times—7 sc.

**Rounds 5–10:** Sc in each st around; join  
with slip st in first sc at end of last round.  
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** =  
chain; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es);  
[ ] = work directions in brackets the number  
of times specified; \* = repeat whatever  
follows the \* as indicated.
