What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Sashay®:
1 ball 1947 Patriotic

Susan Bates® Double Pointed Knitting Needles: 5 mm [US 8]

Glue that bonds securely to many surfaces (such as Crazy® glue), one pair of flip flops.

GAUGE: Gauge is not essential to this project.

Buy Yarn



RED HEART® Boutique Sashay®, Art. E782, available in multicolor 3.5 oz (100 g), 30 yd (27 m) balls



Freedom Flip Flops

Show your patriotic colors right down to your toes! Sashay is made into a ruffle similar to making I-cord, and then glued to flip flops. Great in any color for a whole wardrobe of ruffled flip flops.

FLIP FLOP (Make 2)

Using two double pointed needles, cast on 3 sts.

Row 1 (Right side): Knit across, slide sts to opposite end of needle, do not turn.

Repeat Row 1 until piece measures approximately 12" (30.5 cm) from cast on edge, depending on the length of the flip flop.

Bind off all sts in knit.

FINISHING

Fold finished piece in half lengthwise. With top of flip flop facing, thread piece between sole of flip flop and upper so that center of piece is aligned perpendicularly with upper, and lengths are to each side. Wrap each length of piece around upper on corresponding side. Tack down to upper with glue and allow to dry.

Repeat for second flip flop.

ABBREVIATION

cm = centimeters; **k** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es).
