## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Mixology Prints™:**  
1 ball 942 Calypso A  
**RED HEART® Mixology Solids™:**  
1 ball 862 Royal B  
**RED HEART® Mixology Swirl™:**  
1 ball 9942 Calypso C

**Susan Bates® Knitting Needles:**  
12.75 mm [US 17]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 7 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 10 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stitch Pattern.  
**CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

## Mix It Up Cowl

*This easy-knit cowl uses 3 balls of super bulky Mixology yarn in coordinating shades. Let your creativity go wild and choose from any of the artisanal shades in Solids, Prints or Swirl options.*

**Cowl Measures 9" wide x 30" circumference [23 cm x 76 cm]**

### SPECIAL STITCHES

**K2TOG** = Knit 2 sts together.

**YO** = Yarn over

### STITCH PATTERN

**Rows 1 and 3 (Right Side):** Knit.

**Rows 2 and 4 (Wrong Side):** Purl.

**Rows 5 and 9 (Right Side):** Purl.

**Rows 6 and 8 (Wrong Side):** Knit.

**Row 7 (Right Side):** \*YO, k2tog; repeat from \* to end of row.

**Row 10 (Wrong Side):** Purl.

Repeat Rows 1–10 for Stitch Pattern.

### NOTE

Knit first and last stitch on every row and work center 14 sts in Stitch Pattern.

### COWL

With **A**, cast on 16 sts.

**First Row (Wrong Side):** K1, P14, K1.

Begin working Row 1 (Right Side) of Stitch Pattern keeping first and last st in knit, and center 14 sts in Stitch Pattern. Continue until 1 repeat (Rows 1-10) have been completed. Cut **A**.

**Next Rows:** Change to **B** and work Rows 1-10 of Stitch Pattern. Cut **B**.

**Next Rows:** Change to **C** and work Rows 1-10 of Stitch Pattern. Cut **C**.

**Next Rows:** Change to **B** and work Rows 1-10 of Stitch Pattern. Cut **B**.

Repeat Rows 1-10 in **A-B** one more time. There will be 2 repeats of each color **A, B, C, B, A, B, C, B** — 8 stripes total. Bind off all sts knitwise on Row 10 of second stripe of **B**.

### FINISHING

With yarn needle, sew cast on row to bind off row, forming a circle. Weave in all ends.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = colors A, B, C; **cm** = centimeters; **K** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **P** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **St st** = Stockinette stitch; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
