What you will need:

RED HEART® Mixology Solids™:
1 ball each 342 Taupe A and 102 Ivory C

RED HEART® Mixology Print™:
1 ball 959 Retro Print B

RED HEART Mixology Swirl™:
1 ball 9959 Retro D

RED HEART® Super Saver®:
1 skein 313 Aran E

Note: Only a small quantity of E is needed for this project.

Retro Crochet Wall Hangings

Choose your favorite combination of Mixology yarns for a crochet wall hanging. Designed at a beginner level of crochet, so you don't need much experience to create this modern room accent.

See LW4980 and LW4981 for alternate designs in other color ways.

What you will need continued:

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
9mm [US M-13]

Large eye yarn needle, ¼" diameter x 12" long (6 mm x 30.5 cm) dowel or stick and 1 yd (.91 meters) twine

GAUGE: 6 sts = 4" (10 cm); 4 rows = 4" (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

Wall hanging measures 6½" wide and 11" long (16.5 x 28 cm).

Notes

1. Wall hanging is worked in turned rows.
2. To change color, work the last stitch to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Drop old color to wrong side and proceed with new color. Do not cut any color until instructed.

WALL HANGING

With **A**, ch 11.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; change to **B**, turn—10 sts. Cut **A**.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as first tr here and throughout), tr in each st across; change to **C**, turn. Cut **B**.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc here and throughout), hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 4, tr in each st across; change to **A**, turn. Cut **C**.

Row 5: Ch 2, hdc in each st across; change to **D**, drop **A**, turn.

Row 6: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in each st across; change to **A**, turn. Cut **D**.

Row 7: Ch 3, dc in next 2 sts; change to **B**, drop **A**, dc in next 4 sts; change to **C**, drop **B**, dc in last 3 sts, turn.

Row 8: Ch 3, dc in next 2 sts; change to **B**, drop **C**, dc in next 4 sts; change to **A**, drop **B**, dc in last 3 sts, turn.

Row 9: Repeat Row 7; change to **D** at end of row. Cut **A**, **B**, and **C**.

Rows 10–11: Repeat Row 3.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Refer to photograph as a guide for placement.

Fringe

Cut 24 strands of **E**, each 8" (20.5 cm) long; separate into 6 groups of 4 strands. Fold strands in half to form a loop. With right side facing and working in opposite side of foundation chains, insert crochet hook from front to back in first stitch. Place fold on hook and draw fold through, forming a loop. Thread ends of strands through loop and pull to tighten. Repeat to attach fringe to next 2 stitches and last 3 stitches. Trim ends evenly.

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Hanging Loops

Cut 5 strands of **E**, each 8" (20.5 cm) long. Fold each strand in half and tie ends together with an overhand knot to form a loop. With right side and top edge facing, thread folded end of loop from front to back through ch-3 space of Row 11, open strands of hanging loop below knot and insert the folded end. Pull up the folded end so knotted end tightens around stitch. Repeat to join remaining 4 hanging loops in top of 4th, 6th, 8th, and last stitches. Adjust as needed to place knots on wrong side. Weave in ends. Insert dowel or stick through hanging loops and tie on twine for hanging.

ABBREVIATION

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = treble (triple) crochet.
