What you will need:

RED HEART® Twilight™, 6 balls 9942 Pixie

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 11.5mm [US P-16]

Large eye plastic needle

GAUGE: Rows 2-8 = 6" [15 cm]. Gauge is not critical for this project.

BUY YARN



RED HEART® Twilight™, Art. E829 available in 3.5 oz (100 g), 59 yd (54 m) balls



Confetti Super Scarf

This oversized scarf is fashioned in a quick-crochet jumbo yarn. Since it is a chainette style of yarn it won't weigh you down. Choose any of the spectacular colors that have a tiny bit of sparkle.

Scarf measures 10" x 86" [25.5 x 218.5 cm]

Special Stitches

beg fp tri st (beginning front post triangle stitch) = Ch 3, yarn over, insert hook from front side of work to back and to front again around the post of next dc, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops on hook); yarn over, insert hook in next dc, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (3 loops on hook); yarn over and draw through all 3 loops.

fp tri st (front post triangle stitch) = Working in next 3 dc: yarn over, insert hook in first dc, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops on hook); yarn over, insert hook from front side of work to back and to front again around post of second dc, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook (3 loops on hook); yarn over, insert hook in third dc, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (4 loops on hook); yarn over and draw through all 4 loops.

SCARF

Ch 20. Row 1 (Wrong Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, [ch 3, skip next 2 ch, sc in next ch] across; turn—7 sc and 6 ch-3 spaces. Row 2 (Right Side): Ch 1, sc in first sc, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 space, [ch 3, skip next sc, sc in next ch-3 space] across, ch 1, sc in last sc; turn—8 sc, 2 ch-1 spaces and 5 ch-3 spaces. Row 3: Ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch-1 here and throughout), skip first ch-1 space, [skip next sc, 3 dc in next ch-3 space] across, skip next sc and ch-1 space, ch 1, dc in last sc; turn—17 dc and 2 ch-1 spaces.



Row 4: Ch 5 (counts as first dc and ch-2 here and throughout), skip next ch-1 space, fp tri st, [ch 3, fp tri st] 4 times, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of beginning ch-4; turn—2 dc, 2 ch-2 spaces, 5 fp tri sts and 4 ch-3 spaces. Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first dc, ch 3, skip next ch-2 space, sc in first fp tri st, [ch 3, skip next ch-3 space, sc in next fp tri st] 4 times, ch 3, sc in 3rd ch of beginning ch-5; turn—7 sc and 6 ch-3 spaces. Row 6: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 2 dc in first ch-3 space, [skip next sc, 3 dc in next ch-3 space] 4 times, skip next sc, 2 dc in next ch-3 space, dc in last sc; turn—18 dc.

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Row 7: Beg fp tri st; [ch 3, fp tri st] across, working last “leg” of last fp tri st in top of beginning ch-3; turn—1 beg fp tri st, 5 ch-3 spaces and 5 fp tri sts.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first fp tri st, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, [ch 3, skip next fp tri st, sc in next ch-3 space] across, ch 3, sc in top of beginning ch of beg fp tri st; turn—7 sc and 6 ch-3 spaces.

Rows 9-99: Repeat Rows 2-8 thirteen times or until scarf measures desired length.

Row 100: Repeat Row 2. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain(s); **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **g** = grams; **m** = meters; **mm** = millimeters; **oz** = ounces; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); yd = yards; **()** = work all directions in parentheses in the indicated stitch or space; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
