What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®:

1 skein each of 334 Buff **A**, 672 Spring Green **B**, 369 Mushroom **C**, 324 Bright Yellow **D**, 319 Cherry Red **E**, and 3950 Charcoal **F**

Note: Only a small amount of each yarn color is needed.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:

3.75 mm [US F-5].

Polyester fiberfill, 18" [45.5 cm] thin gold ribbon (for hanger), stitch marker, yarn needle.

GAUGE: 20 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 20 rows/rounds = 4" [10 cm] in single crochet. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

BUY YARN



RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yds (333 m); stripes, prints, multis and heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yds (215 m); flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



Happy Hamburger Ornament

Crochet a foodie favorite and decorate your tree deliciously! Our smiling hamburger is perfect for anyone who prefers a good juicy burger to a fancy meal!

Ornament measures about 3½" [9 cm] tall.

Special Stitch

Fpdc (Front post double crochet) =

Yarn over, insert hook from front side of work to back and to front again around post of indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), [yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

Notes

1. Hamburger is made from 7 pieces: Top Bun, Bottom Bun, Lettuce, 2 Burger Patty pieces, Cheese and Tomato.
2. All pieces are sewn together to complete the happy little hamburger.
3. Gauge is not critical for this project. Work tightly so stuffing will not show between stitches.
4. Use photograph as a guide for placement of pieces to be sewn together.

TOP BUN

With **A**, ch 2.

Round 1 (right side): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook—6 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rounds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed.

Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around—12 sc.

Round 3: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—18 sc.

Round 4: [Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—24 sc.

Round 5: [Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—30 sc.

Round 6: Sc in each sc around.

Round 7: [Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—36 sc.

Round 8: Sc in each sc around.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

BOTTOM BUN

With **A**, ch 2.

Rounds 1-5: Work same as Rounds 1-5 of Top Bun—30 sc.

Round 6: [Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—36 sc.

Round 7: Sc in each sc around. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

LETTUCE

With **B**, ch 4.

Round 1: Work 11 dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc); join with slip st in top of beginning ch—12 dc.

Round 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same st as joining, 2 dc in each remaining dc around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—24 dc.

Round 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in same st as joining, 2 sc in each remaining dc around; join with slip st in first sc—48 sc.

Round 4: Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, *ch 2, sc in next st; repeat from * around, ch 2; join with slip st in first sc—48 sc and 48 ch-2 spaces.

Fasten off.

BURGER PATTY (make 2)

With **C**, ch 2.

Rounds 1-6: Work same as Rounds 1-6 of Bottom Bun—36 sc.

Round 7: [Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—42 sc.

Fasten off first Burger Patty. Do not fasten off second Burger Patty.

Hold the two Burger Patty pieces with wrong sides together and stitches matching.

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Joining Round: Working through both thicknesses, slip st in each st around, adding a tiny amount of stuffing between the patties before completing the round. Fasten off.

CHEESE

With **D**, ch 14.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across—13 sc.

Rows 2-12: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

TOMATO

With **E**, ch 4.

Round 1: Work 11 dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc); join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3—12 dc.

Round 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), Fpdc around same st as joining, *dc in next st, Fpdc around same st as last dc made; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3—24 sts.

Round 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next st, Fpdc around same st as last dc made, *dc in next 2 sts, Fpdc around same st as last dc made; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3—36 sts.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

With **A**, sew edges of Bottom Bun to one side of Lettuce, stuffing lightly before completing seam.

With **A**, sew Bottom Bun/Lettuce to one side of Patty, sewing through all thicknesses and pulling slightly to draw pieces together. Sew several stitches, back and forth through all of the layers, until all pieces feel secure.

With **D**, sew Cheese to top of Patty. Sew the corners of the cheese, while stretching the points slightly, down the sides of the Patty.

With **A**, sew Tomato to top of Cheese, sewing through all thicknesses and pulling slightly to draw pieces together. Sew several stitches, back and forth through all of the layers, until all pieces feel secure.

With **A**, sew edges of Top Bun to top of Tomato, stuffing lightly before completing seam.


Face: With yarn needle and **F**, using photograph as a guide, embroider a back stitch smile and French knot eyes on front of Top Bun.

Fold gold ribbon in half. Insert crochet hook around a few stitches at top of ornament, place ribbon fold on hook and draw through to form a loop. Thread ends of ribbon through loop and pull to tighten. Tie ends together with bow or overhand knot to form hanging loop.


Weave in any remaining ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C, etc. = Color A, B, C, etc.; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
