What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 2 skeins 319 Cherry Red

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Stitch markers, yarn needle

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.

Crocheted Snowflake Table Runner

This bright runner will add a festive lacy accent to a dining room table or buffet. Crochet it in the color shown, or in whatever color is best for your unique decorating style.

Table Runner: 18½" [47 cm] wide by 90½" [230 cm] long

Finished Measurements

Snowflakes width at widest point

Snowflake 1 = 5" [12.5 cm]

Snowflake 2 = 10¾" [27.5 cm]

Snowflake 3 = 6" [15 cm]

Snowflake 4 = 8¼" [21 cm]

Snowflake 5 = 7¼" [18.5 cm]

Snowflake 6 = 3" [7.5 cm]

NOTES

Instructions are given for individual Snowflakes. Snowflakes are worked in joined rounds with right side facing throughout. To assemble Snowflakes, complete all rounds of first snowflake only. Following assembly diagram, join remaining Snowflakes in indicated ch-spaces while completing last round. Mark placements for joins with stitch markers. To work joining, ch 2, drop loop from hook, insert hook in center ch of indicated ch-space, pull up dropped loop, ch 2, continue working last round of instructions.

Runner is made up of three repeats of assembly diagram plus an extra Snowflake 2 and 3 for opposite end. Add or decrease number of repeats as desired. Snowflakes will need to be pulled and shaped a bit together. Feel free to arrange Snowflakes in your own patterns. Keep checking that piece lays flat, changing join placements as necessary.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Picot: Ch 6, slip st in 6th ch from hook.

Triple Picot: Ch 6, slip st in 6th ch from hook, mark this ch, [ch 5, slip st in marked ch] twice.



SNOWFLAKE 1 (make 2 for each repeat; 6 total for Runner)

Round 1 (Right Side): Ch 4, join with slip st to form ring, ch 1, work 12 sc in ring, join with slip st in first sc - 12 sc.

Round 2: *Ch 7, skip next st, slip st in next st; repeat from * around working last slip st in same space as beginning ch-7 - 6 ch-7 spaces.

Round 3: Slip st in next 3 ch, *(slip st, [ch 5, slip st] 3 times) all in next ch, slip st in next 6 ch; repeat from * 5 times, slip st in next 3 ch, (slip st, [ch 5, slip st] 3 times) all in next ch, slip st in last 3 ch - 18 ch-5 spaces. Fasten off.

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slip st in first sc – 84 sc, 12 picots and 6 triple picots.
Fasten off.



SNOWFLAKE 3 (make 2 for each repeat plus 1 extra for end; 7 total for Runner)

Round 1 (Right Side): Ch 4, join with slip st to form ring, *ch 5, slip st in ring; repeat from * 5 times – 6 ch-5 spaces.

Round 2: Slip st in next 3 ch, ch 9, (counts as dc, plus ch-6 for triple picot), triple picot in 6th ch from hook, ch 5, *dc in center ch of next ch-5, triple picot, ch 5; repeat from * around, join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-9 – 6 triple picot and 6 ch-5 spaces. Fasten off.



SNOWFLAKE 4 (make 2 for each repeat; 6 total for Runner)

Round 1 (Right Side): Ch 4, join with slip st to form ring, ch 1, work 12 sc in

ring, join with slip st in first sc – 12 sc.

Round 2: Ch 8 (counts as dc and ch 5), skip next st, *dc in next st, ch 5, skip next st; repeat from * around, join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-8 – 6 dc and 6 ch-5 spaces.

Round 3: *Sc in next 2 ch, (sc, ch 3, sc) all in next ch, sc in next 2 ch, slip st in next st; repeat from * around, join with slip st in first sc – 36 sc and 6 ch-3 spaces.

Round 4: Slip st in each st to next ch-3 space, ch 5, slip st in same space, ch 5, slip st in next slip st, ch 5, *(slip st, ch 5, slip st) all in next ch-3 space, ch 5, slip st in next slip st, ch 5; repeat from * around, join with slip st in first slip st – 18 ch-5 spaces.

Round 5: Slip st in next 3 ch, *triple picot, ch 1, skip next 3 ch, slip st in next ch, ch 5, skip next 6 ch, slip st in next ch, ch 1, slip st in in center ch of next ch-5; repeat from * around, join with slip st in first slip st. Fasten off.



SNOWFLAKE 5 (make 2 for each repeat; 6 total for Runner)

Round 1 (Right Side): Ch 4, join with slip st to form ring, ch 1, work 12 sc in ring, join with slip st in first sc – 12 sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 3, *sc in

next st, ch 3; repeat from * around, join with slip st in first sc – 12 sc and 12 ch-3 spaces.

Round 3: Slip st in next ch-3 space, *(dc, ch 3, dc) all in next ch-3 space, slip st in next ch-3 space; repeat from * around, working last slip st in same space as first slip st – 12 dc and 6 ch-3 spaces.

Round 4: *Sc in next dc, (sc, ch 5, sc) all in next ch-3 space, sc in next dc, slip st in next slip st; repeat from * around, join with slip st in first sc – 24 sc and 6 ch-5 spaces.

Round 5: *Slip st in next sc, slip st in next 3 ch, triple picot, slip st in next 2 ch, slip st in next 2 sc, slip st in next slip st, slip st in next sc; repeat from * around – 6 triple picots. Fasten off.



SNOWFLAKE 6 (make 4 for each repeat; 12 total for Runner)

Round 1 (Right Side): Ch 4, join with slip st to form ring, ch 8 (counts as dc and ch 5), [dc in ring, ch 5] 5 times, join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-8 – 6 dc and 6 ch-5 spaces. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Immerse in cool water, squeeze out excess water, taking care not to wring or twist. Place the piece on a flat, covered surface, gently stretch to open lace pattern. Leave until completely dry.

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ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
