**What you will need:**

**RED HEART® Reflective™:** 2 balls 8429 Grey

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:** 6.0 mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** In pattern, 11 sts = 4.5" (11.5 cm) and 7 rows = 4" (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

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**RED HEART® Reflective™, Art. E820,** available in 3.5 oz (100 g), 88 yd (80 m) balls



# Faux Bobble Wristers

Wristers are perfect for when you need your fingers for something important, like texting or crocheting. Wristers make a great gift! They'll love the way this yarn reflects the flash of a camera!

**Wristers measure 9" (23 cm) in circumference x 10" long (25.5 cm).**

### Notes

1. Ribbing is worked back and forth in rows. Arm and Palm are made in joined rounds.
2. Thumbhole section is worked in rows and rounds.
3. To increase circumference, work additional rows of Ribbing in multiples of 2. For longer Wristers, work additional repeats of Rounds 2-5, ending on a Round 2 or 4.

### Special Stitches

**beg dc (beginning double crochet) =** Ch 2, insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, yarn over and pull up a loop, insert hook in first st, yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), [yarn over, draw through 2 loops] twice.

**beg tr (beginning treble crochet) =** Ch 3, insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, yarn over and pull up a loop, insert hook in next ch, yarn over and pull up a loop, insert hook in first st, yarn over and pull up a loop (4 loops on hook), [yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 3 times.

**fp sc (front post single crochet) =** Insert hook from front to back and to front again around post of indicated stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook.

**bpsc (back post single crochet) =** Insert hook from back to front and to back again around post of indicated stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook.

### Special Technique

**Invisible join =** After last stitch in round is made, cut yarn leaving a 6" (15 cm) tail. Pull tail completely through last stitch. Thread the tail onto yarn needle and weave the end under the top 2 loops of the first stitch of the round and then back down into the center of the top of the last stitch of the round.

## WRISTER (make 2)

### Ribbing

Leaving a long tail for sewing, ch 5.

**Row 1 (Wrong Side):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; turn—4 sc.

**Row 2 (Right Side):** Ch 1, sc in each ch across; turn.

**Rows 3-22:** Repeat Row 2.

With Wrong Sides of Rows 1 and 22 held together, slip st in last st of Row 1.

### Arm

**Round 1 (Right Side):** Working in ends of rows, ch 1, sc in each row around; join with slip st in first sc; turn—22 sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, tr in next st, \*sc in next st, tr in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first sc; turn—11 sc, 11 tr.

**Round 3:** Beg dc, dc in each st around; join with slip st in beg dc; turn—22 dc.

**Round 4:** Beg tr, sc in next st, \*tr in next st, sc in next st; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in beg tr; turn—11 tr, 11 sc.

**Round 5:** Repeat Round 3.

**Rounds 6-8:** Repeat Rounds 2-4.

**Round 9:** Repeat Round 3.

**Round 10:** Repeat Round 2.

### Thumbhole

**Row 11:** Beg dc, dc in each st around; do not join, turn—22 dc.

**Row 12:** Beg tr, sc in next st, \*tr in next st, sc in next st; repeat from \* around; turn—11 tr, 11 sc.

**Round 13:** Repeat Round 3 of Arm.

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### Palm

**Round 14:** Repeat Round 4 of Arm.

**Round 15:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in each st around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch; turn—22 hdc.

**Round 16:** Ch 1, fpdc around first st, bpsc around next st, \*fpdc around next st, bpsc around next st; repeat from \* around—11 fpdc, 11 bpsc. Do not join or turn.

**Round 17:** Slip st in first st, (ch 1, slip st) in each st around, ch 1; join with slip st in first ch. Fasten off with invisible join (see Special Technique).

### FINISHING

With beginning tail, sew first and last rows of Ribbing together.

Thumbhole Opening (optional)  
Join yarn with slip st at bottom of Thumbhole in Round 10; working in ends of rows, work 5 slip sts evenly spaced up first edge, slip st in top of Thumbhole in Round 14; working in ends of rows, work 5 slip sts evenly down other edge; join with slip st in first slip st. Fasten off with invisible join.

Weave in all ends.

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### ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain(s); **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet(s); **g** = grams; **hdc** = half double crochet(s); **m** = meters; **mm** = millimeters; **oz** = ounces; **sc** = single crochet(s); **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yd** = yards; **( )** = work all directions in parentheses in the indicated stitch or space; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; **\* or \*\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
