Yarn needed:

RED HEART® Super Saver® – 1 skein each
254 Pumpkin, 324 Bright Yellow, and 1102 Freshmint or colors of your choice

Tools needed:

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook – 5.5 mm [US I-9]
Yarn needle

What you'll do:

Slip knot

Chain (ch)

Single crochet (sc)

Work back and forth in rows

Turn

Increase

Repeat

Fasten off

Check gauge

Weave in ends

Gauge:

12 sc = 4" [10 cm];
15 rows = 4" [10 cm].

BUY YARN



Beginner Crochet Banner

Hold your crochet banner high and wave it with pride. This quick and easy banner can have as many flags as you wish. Use different yarn colors to welcome any special day or holiday.



Project size: One triangular flag measures about 4" [10 cm] wide (at widest) x 3½" [9 cm] long.

ABBREVIATIONS USED

ch = chain
sc = single crochet

PATTERN

Pattern Notes

1. Banner is made from triangular flags that are strung onto a long chain for hanging.
2. Each triangle is worked back and forth in rows from the lower tip up to the top edge.
3. Increases are worked at the beginning and end of every other row to create the triangular shape.

BANNER

Flags (make as many as desired using yarn colors of your choice)
Make a slip knot and place it on the hook.



Chain 2.



Row 1: Single crochet (sc) in second chain (ch) from hook.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, make 3 sc in the sc of Row 1 - you will have 3 sc in this row.



Row 4: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first sc (increase made), sc in next sc, 2 sc in last sc - 5 sc.



Row 6: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc - 7 sc.



Fasten off.



Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.



Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.



Rows 7-12: Repeat Rows 5 and 6 for 3 more times - 13 sc in Row 12.

Row 13: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.



Repeat all of the previous steps to make more triangular flags.

Hanging Chain

Make a slip knot and place it on the hook. Make chain stitches until hanging chain measures about 48" [122 cm] or desired length. Fasten off.



Finishing

Use crochet hook to weave hanging chain through spaces between stitches at the top corners of the flags.

Using yarn needle, weave in yarn tails.
