## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Baby Hugs™ Medium:** 1 ball for each Bib  
4957 Hopscotch or 4704 Happy

**Susan Bates® Knitting**  
**Needles:** 5.5 mm [US 9], yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 16 sts = 4" [10 cm];  
22 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Garter  
Stitch. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**  
Use any size needle to obtain  
the gauge.

**RED HEART® Baby Hugs™ Medium,** Art E404 available in solid colors 4.5oz (127g), 247 yd (225m) and multicolor 4 oz (113g), 208 yd (190m) balls.



# Knit Baby Bibs

These colorful knit bibs are appreciated by busy parents! The premium acrylic yarn is completely machine wash and dry and has been Oeko-Tex tested and certified free from harmful levels of over 300 substances.

Directions are for size 0-3 months. Changes for sizes 3-6 months and 6-12 months are in parenthesis.

**Baby Bib measures:** About 8½" long (from top neck band edge to bottom point) x 9" wide (at widest point) [21 cm x 23 cm].

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**K2tog** = Knit 2 sts together as one.  
**YO** = Yarn over. Yarn over needle

## STITCH PATTERN

### 2 x 2 Ribbing

**Row 1:** (Right Side): \*K2, p2\* across row.  
**Rows 2 (Wrong Side):** \*Knit the knit sts, purl the purl sts\* across row.  
Repeat Rows 1-2 for 2 x 2 Ribbing.

## BABY BIB

### Neck Band

Cast on 60 (68, 72) sts.

**Next Rows:** Work in 2 x 2 Ribbing for 5 (6, 6) rows.

**Next Row:** Bind off 20 (22, 24) sts, knit next 20 (23, 24) sts, bind off remaining 20 (23, 24) sts.

You will have 20 (23, 24) sts left on needle.

Cut yarn and tie off.

### Bib

**Next Row (increase Row):** Join yarn. K2, yo, knit across row—21 (24, 25) sts.

**Next Row (increase Row):** K2, yo, knit across row—22 (25, 26) sts.

**Next Rows (increase Rows):** Continue in this manner until there are 32 (36, 40) sts total.

**Next Row (decrease Row):** K1, k2tog, yo, k2tog, knit across row—31 (35, 39) sts.

**Next Row (decrease Row):** K1, k2tog, yo, k2tog, knit across row—30 (34, 38) sts.

**Next Rows (decrease Rows):** Continue in this manner until there are 4 (4, 4) sts left.



**Next Row:** Bind off all sts. Cut yarn and tie off.

## FINISHING

With Yarn needle, sew Neck Band ends together (use photo as a guide). Weave in all ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**K** = knit; **k2tog** = Knit the next two stitches together; **mm** = millimeters; **P** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **yo** = yarn over.

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
