What you will need:

**Aunt Lydia's® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10:** 1 ball each 494 Victory Red **A** and 12 Black **B**

**Note:** Only small quantities of each color are needed for this project.

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:** 2.75 mm [US C-2]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** Approximately 7 sc = 1" [2.5 cm]. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Kiss-able Lips Appliqué

Crochet these luscious lips and appliqué them to a denim jacket or use them in your scrapbook. This easy crochet appliqué pattern can be crocheted in any pink or red shade you prefer. Appliqué can be sewn to any fabric or attached with fabric glue.

**Lips measure 3½" wide x 1¾" high [9 cm x 4.5 cm].**

**Note:** Use double strand of Thread throughout.

### Special Stitch

**sc2tog** = [draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

### LIPS

Beginning at bottom of Lip, with **A**, ch 8.

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 5 chs, 2 sc in last ch; turn—9 sc.

**Rows 2-5:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; turn—17 sc.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, slip st in first sc, sc in next 15 sc; turn (1 sc left unworked)—16 sts.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next sc, skip 1 sc, 5 dc in next sc, skip 2 sc, slip st in next sc, skip 2 sc, 5 dc in next sc, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc, sc2tog; do not turn—15 sts.

### Edge

Ch 1, work 3 sc in corner of Mouth, sc evenly to opposite corner of Mouth, 3 sc in corner, sc in next 3 sts (the third sc should be worked in the first dc of Row 7), 2 sc in each of the next 3 dc, sc in next dc, slip st in slip st, sc in next dc, 2 sc in each of the next 3 dc, sc in next 3 sts; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off and weave in ends.


Referring to photo for placement, with one strand of **B**, embroider with back stitches between Rows 5 and 6, going slightly upwards at sides to make a smile.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color A, Color B, Color C etc.; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
