What you will need:

Size Child
RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein 3985 Sunrise C

Size Woman
RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each 3945 Blue Suede A and 726 Coral B

Size Man
RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein 3945 Blue Suede A

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 16 sc = 4" (10 cm);
17 rows = 4" (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Crochet Mittens for All

Crochet a whole family of mittens with this pattern that is given in 3 sizes – child, woman and man. They're great for snowman making with extra-long cuffs to keep out the cold and snow!

Directions are for size Child 4/5 yrs. Changes for sizes Woman's Medium and Man's Large are in parentheses.

Hand circumference: 6 (7½, 9½)" [15 (19, 24) cm] **Finished length:** 7½ (11½, 12)" [19 (29, 30.5) cm]

Notes

1. All sections except cuffs are worked in joined rounds. Extra-long cuffs are worked in back loops only of each stitch to create rows of ribbing. Wear them long for added warmth or fold at the wrist.
2. Sizes Child and Man are worked with 1 yarn with no color changes; size Woman is worked with 2 colors in a stripe pattern. Refer to Color Sequences for each size.

Special Abbreviation

sc2tog = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

Special Technique

Join with sc = Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

Color Sequences

Size Child: Work all rounds with C.

Size Woman: Work all rounds of Cuff with A; alternate each round of Hand, Thumbhole, Upper Hand, and Thumb with A and B, working last 7 rounds of Upper Hand with B.

Size Man: Work all rounds with A.

MITTEN (make 2)

Cuff

With C (A, A), ch 15 (21, 24).

Row 1: Working in back loops only, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—14 (20, 23) sc.

Rows 2-18 (2-22, 2-24): Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 19 (23, 25): Holding first and last rows together and working through both thicknesses, slip st in each st across.

Hand

Note For size Woman only, change color in last st of each round.

Round 1: Working in ends of rows, work 18 (22, 26) slip sts evenly spaced around; join with slip st in first st—18 (22, 26) sts.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in first 8 (10, 12) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 (10, 12) sts, 2 sc in last st; join with slip st in first st—20 (24, 28) sts.

Round 3: Ch 1, sc in first 9 (11, 13) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 9 (11, 13) sts, 2 sc in last st; join with slip st in first st—22 (26, 30) sts.

Round 4: Ch 1, sc in first 10 (12, 14) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 10 (12, 14) sts, 2 sc in last st; join with slip st in first st—24 (28, 32) sts.

Size Woman only:

Round 5: Ch 1, sc in first 13 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 13 sts, 2 sc in last st; join with slip st in first st—30 sts.

Size Man only:

Round 5: Ch 1, sc in first 15 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 15 sts, 2 sc in last st; join with slip st in first st—34 sts.

Round 6: Ch 1, sc in first 16 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 16 sts, 2 sc in last st; join with slip st in first st—36 sts.

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Round 7: Ch 1, sc in first 17 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 17 sts, 2 sc in last st; join with slip st in first st—38 sts.

All sizes:

Round(s) 5 (6-8, 8-10): Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first st.

Thumbhole

Round 6 (9, 11): Ch 1, sc in first 20 (26, 32) sts, ch 4 (5, 6), skip remaining sts; join with slip st in first st—20 (26, 32) sts and 1 thumbhole.

Upper Hand

Round 7 (10, 12): Ch 1, sc in each st and ch around; join with slip st in first st—24 (31, 38) sts.

Rounds 8-14, 11-18, 13-23): Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first st.

Size Woman only:

Round 19: Ch 1, sc in first 15 sts, sc2tog, sc in each remaining st around; join with slip st in first st—30 sts.

All sizes:

Round 15 (20, 24): Ch 1, sc in first 10 (13, 17) sts, sc2tog, sc in next 10 (13, 17) sts, sc2tog; join with slip st in first st—22 (28, 36) sts.

Note For size Woman, work remaining rounds with **B**.

Round 16 (21, 25): Ch 1, sc in first 9 (12, 16) sts, sc2tog, sc in next 9 (12, 16) sts, sc2tog; join with slip st in first st—20 (26, 34) sts.

Round 17 (22, 26): Ch 1, sc in first 8 (11, 15) sts, sc2tog, sc in next 8 (11, 15) sts, sc2tog; join with slip st in first st—18 (24, 32) sts.

Round 18 (23, 27): Ch 1, sc in first 7 (10, 14) sts, sc2tog, sc in next 7 (10, 14) sts, sc2tog; join with slip st in first st—16 (22, 30) sts.

Size Child only:

Round 19: Ch 1, [sc2tog] around; join with slip st in first st—8 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Sizes Woman and Man only:

Round 24 (28): Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first st—22 (30) sts.

Round 25 (29): Ch 1, sc in first 9 (13) sts, sc2tog, sc in next 9 (13) sts, sc2tog; join with slip st in first st—20 (28) sts.

Rounds 26 & 27 (30 & 31): Ch 1, [sc2tog] around; join with slip st in first st—5 (7) sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Thumb

Note For size Woman only, change color in last st of each round.

Round 1: Join **C (B, A)** with sc to thumb opening at st closest to upper hand, sc in each st and ch around; join with slip st in first st—8 (9, 12) sts.

Rounds 2-5 (2-8, 2-9): Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first st.

Round 6 (9, 10): Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each st around to last 2 sts, sc2tog; join with slip st in first st—6 (7, 10) sts.

Sizes Child and Man only:

Round 7 (11): Ch 1, [sc2tog] around; join with slip st in first st—3 (5) sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Size Woman only:

Round 10: Ch 1, [sc2tog] around to last st, sc in last st; join with slip st in first st—4 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

FINISHING

Weave end tail through last rounds of thumb and upper hand, pull gently to close and secure.

Weave in ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain(s); **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **()** = work directions in parentheses into same st; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; ***** = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
