



GAUGE: 12 sts = 4½"; Rows 1-18 = 5" in pattern.
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hooks to obtain the gauge.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

K-st = Insert hook from front to back between next 2 vertical bars, yo and draw through to front.

P-st = Insert hook from back to front between next 2 vertical bars, yo and draw through to back.

THROW

With double-ended hook and **A**, ch 120 sts.

Row 1 (Wrong Side): Pick up loop in 2nd ch from hook, * pick up loop in next ch; repeat from * across; turn – 120 loops on hook.

Row 2: With **A** and working from left to right, make a slip knot and draw through 1st loop on hook, * yo and draw through next 2 loops; repeat from * across; DO NOT TURN; working back across row, skip 1st vertical bar, 2 k-st, ** 2 p-st, 2 k-st; repeat from ** across, yo and draw through last vertical bar; turn.

Row 3: With 2nd skein of **A**, yo and draw through 1st loop on hook, * yo and draw through next 2 loops; repeat from * across; DO NOT TURN; working back across row, skip 1st vertical bar, 2 p-st, ** 2 k-st, 2 p-st; repeat from ** across, yo and draw through last vertical bar; turn.

Row 4: With 1st skein of **A**, yo and draw through 1st loop on hook, * yo and draw through next 2 loops; repeat from * across; DO NOT TURN; working back across row, skip 1st vertical bar, 2 k-st, ** 2 p-st, 2 k-st; repeat from ** across, yo and draw through last vertical bar; turn.

Rows 5-6: Repeat Rows 3-4. Fasten off both skeins of **A**.

Row 7: With **D**, make a slip knot and draw through 1st loop on hook, * ch 3, yo and draw through next 2 loops; repeat from * across; DO NOT TURN; working back across row, k-st across; turn. Fasten off **D**.

Row 8: With **B**, make a slip knot and draw through 1st loop on hook, * yo and draw through next 2 loops; repeat from * across; DO NOT TURN; working back across row, skip 1st vertical bar, 2 k-st, ** 2 p-st, 2 k-st; repeat from ** across, yo and draw through last vertical bar; turn.

Row 9: With 2nd skein of **B**, yo and draw through 1st loop on hook, * yo and draw through next 2 loops; repeat from *

Use a double-ended hook to Crochet-Knit this cozy striped throw. It's just the right size for cuddling while reading a bedtime story.

Throw is 45" x 43".

RED HEART® "Super Saver®": 2 skeins each 624 Tea Leaf **A**, 358 Lavender **B**, 400 Grey Heather **C**; 3 skeins 315 Artist Print **D**.

Circular Doubled-ended Hook: 6mm [US J-10].

Crochet Hook: 6mm [US J-10].

Yarn needle.

across; DO NOT TURN; working back across row, skip 1st vertical bar, 2 p-st, ** 2 k-st, 2 p-st; repeat from ** across, yo and draw through last vertical bar; turn.

Row 10: With 1st skein of **B**, yo and draw through 1st loop on hook, * yo and draw through next 2 loops; repeat from * across; DO NOT TURN; working back across row, skip 1st vertical bar, 2 k-st, ** 2 p-st, 2 k-st; repeat from ** across, yo and draw through last vertical bar; turn.

Rows 11-12: Repeat Rows 9-10. Fasten off both skeins of **B**.

Row 13: Repeat Row 7.

Rows 14-18: With **C**, repeat Rows 8-12.

Row 19: Repeat Row 7.

Rows 20-24: With **A**, repeat Rows 8-12.

Row 25: Repeat Row 7.

Rows 26-151: [Repeat Rows 8-25] 7 times.

Rows 152-161: Repeat Rows 8-17.

Row 162: With 2nd skein of **A**, yo and draw through 1st loop on hook, * yo and draw through next 2 loops; repeat from * across; DO NOT TURN; change to **D** and crochet hook in last st. Fasten off both skeins of **A**.



BORDER

With **D**, ch 3, (slip st, ch 3) evenly around outer edge in sts and ends of rows; join to 1st st. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
