



## Holiday Placemat Set

*Set your holiday table in style with this lovely set. Alternate the colors so that you use up all 3 balls of yarn. These are perfect small projects for gift giving.*

INTERMEDIATE

Placemat measures 14½” high x 19” wide. Coaster measures 6” across.

**RED HEART® Holiday:** 1 ball each 9090 Red/Red **A**, 1360 Aran/Gold **B**, and 6060 Green/Green **C**.

**Crochet Hook:** 8mm [US H-8].

Yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 16 sts = 4”. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

### PLACEMAT

With **A**, ch 64.

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; turn – 63 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3; yo and draw up a loop in first sc, yo and draw through 2 loops, skip next sc, yo and draw up a loop in next sc, yo and draw through 2 loops, yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook – **CL** made; \* ch 1, CL (use same sc as last leg of last CL, skip next sc, use next sc); repeat from \* across; dc in last sc (same sc as last leg of last CL); turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first dc, \* sc in next st, sc in next space; repeat from \* to last 2 sts; sc in next st, sc in top of ch-3; turn.

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 twelve more times. Fasten off.

### Border

**Round 1:** With right side facing, attach **A** in first sc of last row worked; ch 1, \* (sc, ch 2, sc) all in first st, work 61 sc across to last st, (sc, ch 2, sc) all in last st, work 41 sc along side to next corner sc; repeat from \* once more; join with a slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

**Round 2:** Attach **B** in any corner ch-2 space; (ch 2, [yo and draw up a loop] twice, yo and draw through all 5 loops on hook – **beginning PS** (puff st) made, ch 1; yo and draw up a loop] 3 times, yo and draw through all 7 loops on hook – **PS** made) all in space, \*\* ch 1, skip next sc, \* PS in next sc, ch 1, skip next sc; repeat from \* to next corner \*\*\*; (PS, ch 1, PS) all in next corner space; repeat from \*\* around, end at \*\*\*; join in top of beginning PS. Fasten off.

**Round 3:** Attach **A** in any corner ch-1 space; ch 1, \*\* (sc, ch 2, sc) all in corner space, ch 2, \* sc in next space, ch 2; repeat from \* to next corner space; repeat from \*\* around; join.

**Round 4:** Slip st into ch-2 space, ch 1, \*\* ([sc, ch 3] twice, sc) all in corner ch-2 space, \* (sc, ch 3, sc) all in next space; repeat from \* to next corner; repeat from \*\* around; join. Fasten off.

### Leaf (Make 4)

With **C**, ch 8; sc in 2nd and 3rd ch from hook, \* (hdc; ch 3, slip st in 3rd ch from hook – **P3** (picot) made; hdc) all in next ch, sc in next ch, (hdc, P3, hdc) all in next ch \*, sc in next ch, (sc, P3, sc) all in last ch; work across opposite side of ch: sc in next ch; repeat from \* to \* once; sc in last 2 ch, slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

Sew 2 Leaves in upper left and lower right corners of placemat. With a double strand of **B**, make 3 French Knot berries between leaves.





**COASTER**

With **B** ch 4; join with a slip st to form a ring.

**Round 1 (Right Side):** Ch 3, 16 dc into ring; join with a slip st in top of ch 3 – 17 sts. Fasten off.

**Round 2:** Attach **A** in any dc; ch 1, 2 sc in each st around; join with a slip st in first sc – 34 sc.

**Round 3:** Ch 4, \* CL, ch 1; repeat from \* around; join with a slip st in 3rd ch of ch-4 – 17 CL.


**Round 4:** Ch 1, 2 sc in same ch as joining, 2 sc in space, \* sc in CL, 2 sc in space; repeat from \* around; join – 52 sc. Fasten off.

**Border**

**Round 1:** With right side facing, attach **B** in any sc; beginning PS in same sc, ch 1, skip next sc, \* PS in next sc, ch 1, skip next sc; repeat from \* around; join in top of beginning PS – 26 PS. Fasten off.

**Round 2:** Attach **A** in any ch-1 space; ch 1, \* sc in space, ch 2; repeat from \* around; join.

**Round 3:** Slip st into ch-2 space, ch 1, \* (sc, ch 3, sc) all in space; repeat from \* around; join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

**RED HEART® Holiday**, Art. E759 available in 3.5 oz (100 g), 235 yd (215 m) balls.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** **A, B, C** = color A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **yo** = yarn over; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
