What you will need:

RED HEART® Shimmer®: 2 (4, 5) balls 1932 Zebra

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Motif = 3½" (9 cm) from corner to corner. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given.

RED HEART® Shimmer®, Art. E763 available in 3.5 oz

(100 g), 280 yd (256 m) and multicolor 3 oz (85 g), 240 yd (220 m) balls



Six Points Top

This flattering, comfortable top can be worn over a tank for a dressier look or a long sleeve top when there's a chill in the air. The soft yarn has a matching metallic thread that adds sparkle to your style.

Directions are given for sizes Small/Medium. Changes for Large/XLarge and 2XLarge/4XLarge are in parentheses.

Finished Bust: 38 (49, 60)" (96.5 [124.5, 152.5] cm)

Finished Length: 17¼ (21¼, 25)" (44 [54, 63.5] cm)

TOP

First Motif

Ch 4; join with a slip st in first ch.

Round 1 (right side): Ch 1, 6 sc in ring; join with s slip st in first sc—6 sc.

Round 2: Ch 4 (counts as first tr), working in back loops of sts, tr in first sc, ch 3, *2 tr in next sc, ch 3; rep from * around; join with a slip st in top of beg ch-4—12 tr; 6 ch-3 spaces.

Round 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in next tr, *(2 sc, ch 3, 2 sc) in next ch-3 space**, sc in each of next 2 tr; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; join with a slip st in first sc—36 sc; 6 ch-3 spaces. Fasten off.

Assembly

Make 57 (89, 121) more motifs same as First Motif, joining each to previous Motif(s) while completing last round, following Assembly Diagram for placement. **Note:** Motifs on right side of chart are to be joined to corresponding motifs on left side of chart; motifs on top of Front are to be joined to corresponding motifs on Back.

Second and Successive Motifs

Work same as First Motif through Round 2.

Round 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in next tr, *(2 sc, ch 1, slip st in corresponding ch-3 space on previous motif, ch 1, 2 sc) in next ch-3 space, sc in each of next 2 tr; repeat from * for all joined corners, *(2 sc, ch 3, 2 sc) in next ch-3 space***, sc in each of next 2 tr;

repeat from ** for all unjoined corners, ending last repeat at ***; join with a slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

Half Motif (make and join 4 [8, 8])

Ch 4; join with a slip st in first ch.

Row 1 (right side): Ch 1, 5 sc in ring, turn—5 sc.

Row 2: Ch 7 (counts as tr, ch 3), sk first sc, working in front loops only, *2 tr in next sc, ch 3; repeat from * twice more, tr in last sc, turn—8 tr; 4 ch-3 spaces.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first tr, *(2 sc, ch 1, slip st in corresponding ch-3 space on previous motif, ch 1, 2 sc) in next ch-3 space**, sc in each of next 2 tr; repeat from * across, ending last repeat at **, sc in 4th ch of beginning ch-7—24 sc; 4 slip st joins. Fasten off.

Bottom Edging

Round 1: With right side facing, join yarn with a slip st in any seam on bottom edge, ch 1, sc evenly around bottom edge; join with a slip st in first sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with a slip st in first sc.

Rep Bottom Edging around neck opening and around each armhole opening.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Block piece to measurements.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); tr = treble crochet; () = work directions in parentheses in same st; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.




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
