### What you will need:

**RED HEART® With Love®:** 1 skein  
1502 Iced Aqua

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
6.5mm [US K-10.5]

Yarn needle, stitch marker

**GAUGE:** 7 sts = 3" (7.5 cm); 9  
rows = 4" (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR  
GAUGE.** Use any size hook to  
obtain the gauge.

## Mermaid Tails Hat

*It's not your imagination...this beautifully  
designed crochet mermaid's tail hat is the perfect  
addition to your hat wardrobe. Or crochet it for  
a lucky gift recipient!*

**Hat measures 21" (53.5 cm)  
circumference at brim.**

### Special stitches

**Fpdc (Front post double crochet)** = Yarn  
over, insert hook from front side of work  
to back and to front again around post of  
indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a  
loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw  
through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over  
and draw through 2 loops (1 loop on hook).

**Fpdc2tog** = Yarn over, insert hook from  
front side of work to back and to front again  
around post of last stitch worked, yarn over  
and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn  
over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on  
hook); yarn over, insert hook from front side  
of work to back and to front again around  
post of next Fpdc, yarn over and pull up a  
loop (4 loops on hook), yarn over and draw  
through 2 loops (3 loops on hook), yarn  
over and draw through 3 loops (1 loop on  
hook).

**FpPuff (Front post puff stitch)** = Yarn over,  
insert hook from front side of work to back  
and to front again around post of indicated  
stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops  
on hook), [yarn over, insert hook from front  
side of work to back and to front again  
around post of same stitch, yarn over and  
pull up a loop] 3 times (9 loops on hook),  
yarn over and draw through 9 loops, ch 1  
tightly to close.

**reverse sc (reverse single crochet)** = Work  
single crochet in opposite direction from  
which you would usually work (left to right  
if you are right-handed and right to left  
if you are left-handed). This stitch is also  
known as crab stitch. It creates a rope-like  
twisted single crochet edging.

### Notes

1. Hat is made in rounds from top down  
with right side facing at all times.
2. Work in joined or continuous rounds  
as indicated. On first continuous round,  
place marker for beginning of round  
and move marker up as each round is  
completed.
3. When instructed to work into a stitch  
"2 rounds below", work into the round  
numbered 2 less than the current round.  
For example, if you are working Round  
11, a stitch "2 rounds below" is in Round  
11 - 2 = Round 9.
4. Closing chain-1 that completes the front  
post puff stitch is not counted as a stitch  
or space. Work stitches of next round  
into the top of the puff and not into the  
ch-1 space.

### HAT

Ch 3; join with slip st to first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1 (right side):** Ch 2 (counts as first  
hdc here and throughout), 6 hdc in ring; join  
with slip st in top of beginning ch—7 hdc.

**Round 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), Fpdc around  
first hdc, [dc in next hdc, Fpdc around  
same hdc] 6 times; join with slip st in top of  
beginning ch—7 dc and 7 Fpdc.

Place marker on first dc and work in  
continuous rounds. Do not join until  
instructed.

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**Round 3:** Ch 2, Fpdc around first dc, Fpdc around first Fpdc, [hdc in next dc, Fpdc around same dc, Fpdc around next Fpdc] 6 times—7 hdc and 14 Fpdc.

**Round 4:** [Hdc in next hdc, Fpdc around same hdc, Fpdc around next 2 Fpdc] 7 times—7 hdc and 21 Fpdc.

**Round 5:** [Hdc in next hdc, Fpdc around same hdc, Fpdc around next 3 Fpdc] 7 times—7 hdc and 28 Fpdc.

**Round 6:** [Hdc in next hdc, hdc in next Fpdc, Fpdc around same Fpdc, Fpdc around next 3 Fpdc] 7 times—14 hdc and 28 Fpdc.

**Round 7:** [Hdc in next 2 hdc, hdc in next Fpdc, Fpdc around same Fpdc, Fpdc around next 3 Fpdc] 7 times—21 hdc and 28 Fpdc.

**Rounds 8 and 9:** [Hdc in next 3 hdc, Fpdc around next 4 Fpdc] 7 times.

**Round 10:** [Hdc in next 3 hdc, hdc in next Fpdc, Fpdc2tog, Fpdc around next 2 Fpdc] 7 times—28 hdc, 14 Fpdc, and 7 Fpdc2tog. Note In next 3 rounds, work first “leg” of Fpdc2tog around 2nd “leg” of Fpdc2tog in previous round.

**Round 11:** Hdc in last Fpdc 2 rounds below, hdc in next 4 hdc, Fpdc2tog, Fpdc around next Fpdc, [hdc in same Fpdc, hdc in next 4 hdc, Fpdc2tog, Fpdc around next Fpdc] 6 times—35 hdc, 7 Fpdc, and 7 Fpdc2tog.

**Round 12:** Hdc in last Fpdc 2 rounds below, hdc in first 5 hdc, Fpdc2tog, [hdc in same Fpdc, hdc in next 5 hdc, Fpdc2tog] 6 times—42 hdc and 7 Fpdc2tog.

**Round 13:** [Hdc in next 6 hdc, Fpdc around next Fpdc2tog] 7 times—42 hdc and 7 Fpdc.

**Round 14:** Hdc in last Fpdc2tog 2 rounds below, hdc in next 5 hdc, skip next hdc, Fpdc around next Fpdc, [hdc in same Fpdc, hdc in next 5 hdc, skip next hdc, Fpdc around next Fpdc] 6 times—42 hdc and 7 Fpdc.

**Round 15:** Hdc in last Fpdc 2 rounds below, hdc in next 5 hdc, skip next hdc, Fpdc around next Fpdc, [hdc in same Fpdc, hdc in next 5 hdc, skip next hdc, Fpdc around next Fpdc] 6 times—42 hdc and 7 Fpdc.

**Round 16:** Repeat Round 13.

**Round 17:** Hdc in last Fpdc 2 rounds below, hdc in next 5 hdc, skip next hdc, FpPuff around next Fpdc, [hdc in same Fpdc, hdc in next 5 hdc, skip next hdc, FpPuff around next Fpdc] 6 times —42 hdc and 7 FpPuff.

**Rounds 18 and 19:** Hdc in each st around—49 hdc.

**Round 20:** Ch 1, reverse sc in each hdc; join with slip st in first reverse sc. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

If necessary, sew opening at top of hat closed with beginning tail. Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; **\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.










  -  = Front post puff stitch (FpPuff)

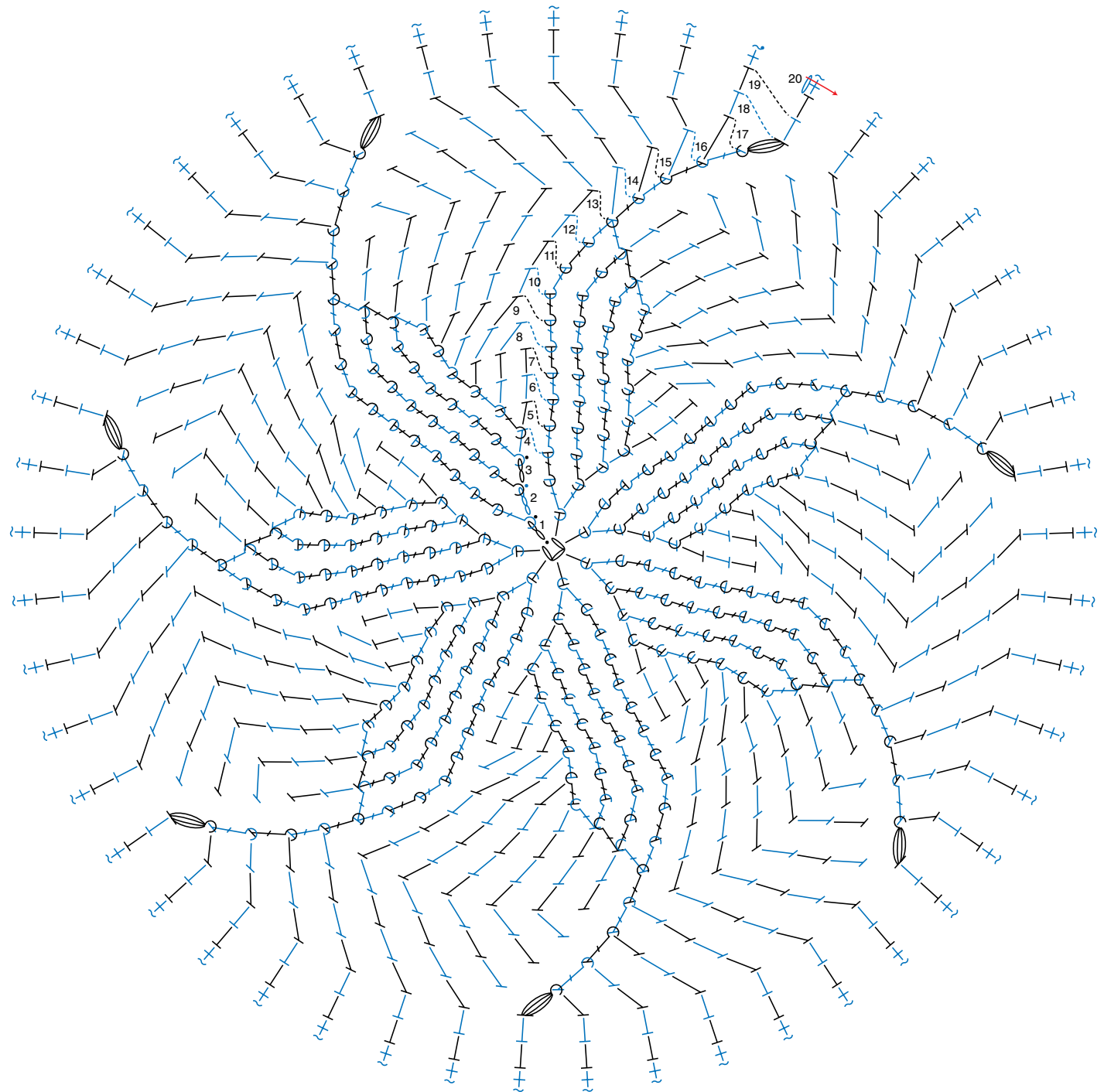











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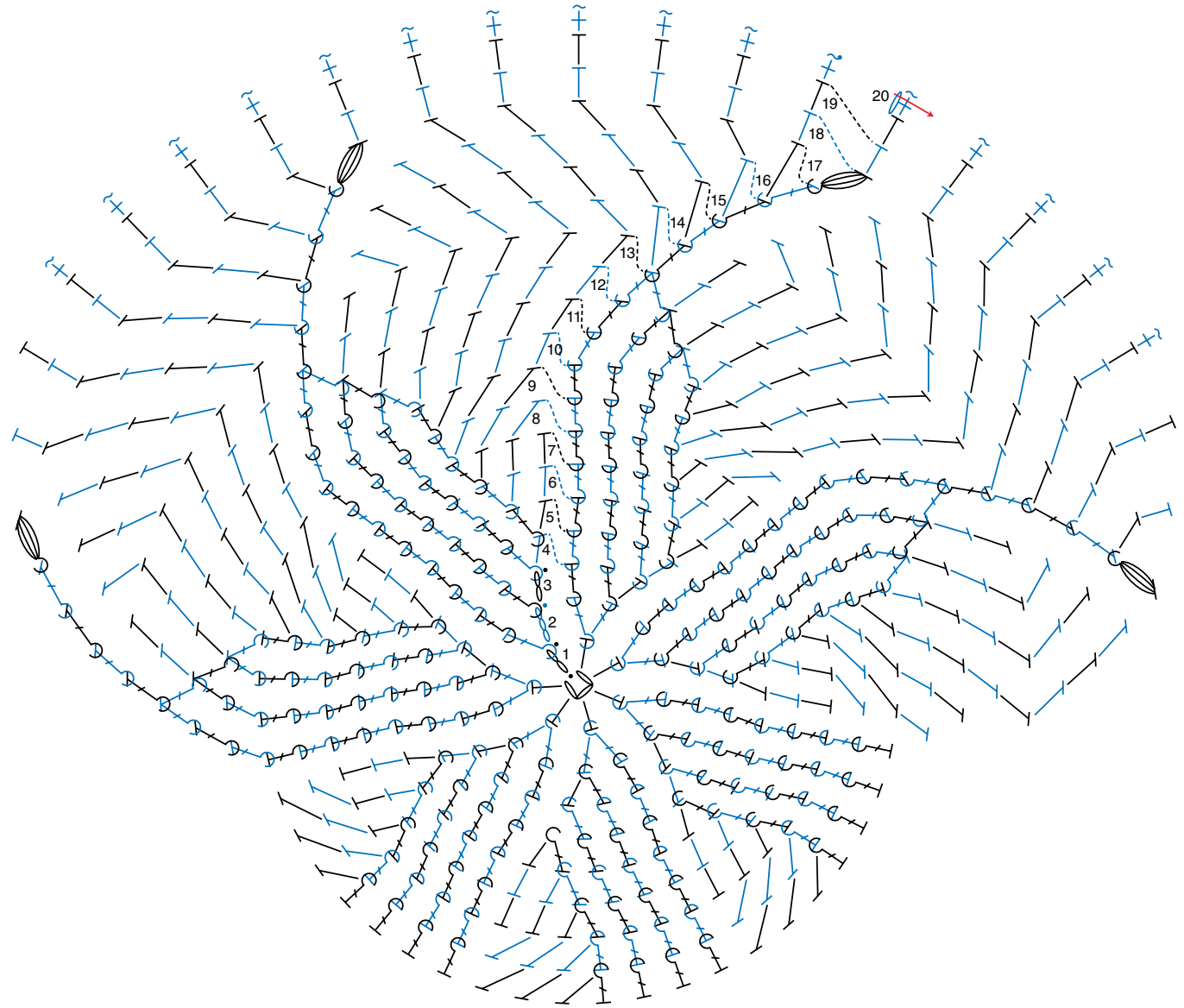


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
