What you will need:

RED HEART® Grande™: 6 balls
307 Oatmeal

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
16 mm [US Q]

Large eye yarn needle

GAUGE: 4 sc = 3¾" (9.5 cm); 4 rows = 3½" (9 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Back to Scotland Cowl

Go back to Scotland or around your hometown in a cowl that will keep you wonderfully warm. The repeated pattern and thick yarn make it quick to crochet.

Cowl measures 24" wide x 56" circumference (61 x 142 cm).

Notes

1. Cowl is worked in joined rounds with right side facing.
2. You may prefer to use a crochet hook to weave in ends.

COWL

Ch 61.

Round 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; join with slip st in first sc—60 sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 3, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc; repeat from * around, ch 3, skip last 2 sc; join with slip st in first sc— 20 sc and 20 ch-3 spaces.

Round 3: Slip st in first ch-3 space, ch 1, 3 sc in same space and in each ch-3 space around; join with slip st in first sc— 60 sc.

Rounds 4–27: Repeat Rounds 2 and 3 twelve times. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
