### What you will need:

**RED HEART® Snuggle Bunny™:**  
1 ball 9937 Carousel

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
6.0mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 8 sc = 4" [10 cm], 10 rows  
sc = 4" [10 cm]. **CHECK YOUR  
GAUGE.** Use any size needles/  
hook to obtain the gauge given.

## Fluffy Bunny Hat

*Soft shaded yarn is perfect for keeping baby warm  
in cute bunny style. Crochet the smaller size and  
have the perfect hat for baby's first photo op.*

**Directions are for a newborn. Changes for  
12 month old are in parenthesis**

**Finished Ribbing Circumference:** 13.5"  
[34.5 cm] (15.5" [39.5 cm]). Ribbing  
stretches to 14-15" [35.5-38 cm] (16-17"  
[40.5-43 cm]).

### Special Stitches

**sc2tog** = [draw up a loop in next st]  
twice, yarn over and draw through all  
3 loops on hook.

### Note

Crown and Ears are worked in continuous  
rounds without joining or turning unless  
otherwise noted.

### HAT

#### Ribbing

Leaving an 8" [20.5 cm] tail at beginning,  
ch 6.

**Row 1 (Right side):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook  
and in each ch across; turn—5 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in back loop only of each sc  
across; turn—5 sc.

**Rows 3-30 (3-34):** Repeat Row 2; do not  
fasten off.

Wrong side facing, sew rib seam together  
using the beginning tail. Weave in loose  
ends and turn Hat Right side out.

#### Crown

Begin Round with yarn still attached from  
Ribbing.

**Round 1 (Right side):** 2 sc in first st, sc in  
each of the next 14 (16) Rows of Ribbing,  
2 sc in next Row, sc in remaining 14 (16)  
Rows—32 (36) sc.

**Rounds 2-9 (2-11):** Sc in each sc around.  
Fasten off, leaving a 14" [35.5 cm] tail.

Turn Hat to Wrong side. Weave the tail in  
and out of the sts in the last Round and pull  
tight to gather the Crown together. Weave  
in loose ends and turn Hat Right side out.

#### Ears (Make 2)

Ch 18; being careful not to twist, join with  
slip st in first ch to make a ring.

**Round 1 (Right side):** Ch 1, (sc in each of  
the next 7 ch, sc2tog in next 2 ch) twice—  
16 sts.

**Round 2:** Sc in each st around.

**Round 3:** (Sc in 6 sts, sc2tog) twice—14 sts.

**Round 4:** Sc in each st around.

**Round 5:** (Sc in 5 sts, sc2tog) twice—12 sts.

**Round 6:** Sc in each st around.

**Round 7:** (Sc in 4 sts, sc2tog) twice—10 sts.

**Round 8:** Sc in each st around.

**Round 9:** (Sc in 3 sts, sc2tog) twice—8 sts.

**Round 10:** Sc in each st around.

**Round 11:** (Sc in 2 sts, sc2tog) twice—6 sts.

**Round 12:** Sc2tog 3 times—3 sts.

Fasten off, pull tail through last 3 sts and  
pull tight.

Weave in loose ends. Referring to photo for  
placement, sew the Ears to both sides of the  
top of the Crown so they flop to the sides.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **mm** =  
millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** =  
stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets  
the number of times specified; **\* or \*\*** =  
repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as  
indicated.
