### What you will need:

**RED HEART® Boutique™ Fur™:**  
19 (21, 24, 26, 28, 30) balls 9914 Teaberry **A**, and 1 (1, 2, 2, 2, 2) ball(s) each 9406 Smoke **B** and 9012 Slate **C**.

**Susan Bates® Knitting Needles:**  
12.75mm [US 17].

Stitch markers, yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 4 sts = 4" [10 cm] in Garter stitch (knit every row).  
**CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

## Fab Fur Jacket

*This plush jacket is an on-trend look that is right on, whatever the occasion. Choose from any of the great shades of this yarn to knit your own unique fur jacket!*

**Directions are for size Small; changes for sizes Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, and 3X are in parentheses.**

**To Fit Bust:** 34 (38, 42, 46, 50, 54)" [86.5 (96.5, 106.5, 117, 127, 137) cm]

**Finished Bust:** 40 (44, 48, 52, 56, 60)" [101.5 (112, 122, 132, 142, 152.5) cm], closed

**Finished Length:** 25 (25½, 26, 26½, 27, 27½)" [63.5 (65, 66, 67.5, 68.5, 70) cm]

### Notes

- Jacket is made in five pieces: Back, two Fronts, and two Sleeves.
- Each piece is worked from the lower edge upwards.

### Special Stitch

**kfb (Knit into front and back)** = Knit next st but do not remove from needle, knit into back loop of same st and remove from needle.

### BACK

With **A**, cast on 24 (26, 28, 30, 32, 34) sts. Work in Garter stitch (knit every row) until piece measures about 10" [25.5 cm] from beginning.

### Shape Sides

**Decrease Row:** K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog—22 (24, 26, 28, 30, 32) sts. Work in Garter stitch until piece measures about 13" [33 cm] from beginning. Repeat Decrease Row – 20 (22, 24, 26, 28, 30) sts. Work in Garter stitch until piece measures about 16" [40.5 cm] from beginning.

### Shape Armholes

**Row 1:** Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4, 4, 5) sts, knit to end of row—18 (19, 21, 22, 24, 25) sts.

**Row 2:** Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4, 4, 5) sts, knit to end of row—16 (16, 18, 18, 20, 20) sts. Work even in Garter stitch until armhole measures about 9 (9½, 10, 10½, 11, 11½)" [23 (24, 25.5, 26.5, 28, 29) cm] from beginning. Bind off loosely.

### LEFT FRONT

With **A**, cast on 16 (17, 18, 19, 20, 21) sts. Work in Garter stitch (knit every row) until piece measures about 10" [25.5 cm] from beginning.

### Shape Side

**Decrease Row (right side):** K2tog, knit to end of row—15 (16, 17, 18, 19, 20) sts. Place a marker on this Decrease Row to indicate right side of piece. Work in Garter stitch until piece measures about 13" [33 cm] from beginning, ending with a wrong side row. Repeat Decrease Row – 14 (15, 16, 17, 18, 19) sts. Work in Garter stitch until piece measures about 16" [40.5 cm] from beginning, ending with a wrong side row.

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### Shape Armhole

**Row 1 (right side):** Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4, 4, 5) sts, knit to end of row—12 (12, 13, 13, 14, 14) sts.

Work even in Garter stitch until armhole measures about 9 (9½, 10, 10½, 11, 11½)" [23 (24, 25.5, 26.5, 28, 29) cm] from beginning.

Bind off loosely.

### RIGHT FRONT

Work same as Left Front, then flip piece over. Left Front and Right Front are mirror-images of each other.

### SLEEVES (make 2)

With **A**, cast on 14 (15, 16, 17, 18, 19) sts. Work in Garter stitch until piece measures about 4" [10 cm] from beginning.

### Shape Sleeve

**Increase Row:** Kfb, knit to last st, kfb—16 (17, 18, 19, 20, 21) sts.

Work in Garter stitch until piece measures about 8" [20.5 cm] from beginning.

Repeat Increase Row—18 (19, 20, 21, 22, 23) sts.

Work in Garter stitch until piece measures about 12" [30.5 cm] from beginning.

Change to **B**.

With **B**, work in Garter stitch for 4 rows.

Change to **C**.

With **C**, work in Garter stitch for 4 rows.

Change to **A**.

Work in Garter stitch until piece measures about 20" [51 cm] from beginning.

Bind off loosely.

### FINISHING

With yarn needle and yarn, sew shoulder seams. Begin sewing each shoulder seam at side edge and sew for 4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 6)" [10 (10, 12.5, 12.5, 15, 15) cm], leaving remaining top edge of Fronts and Back unsewn for neck.

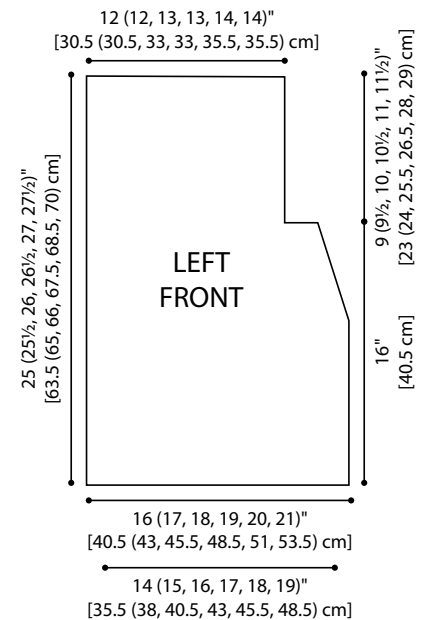
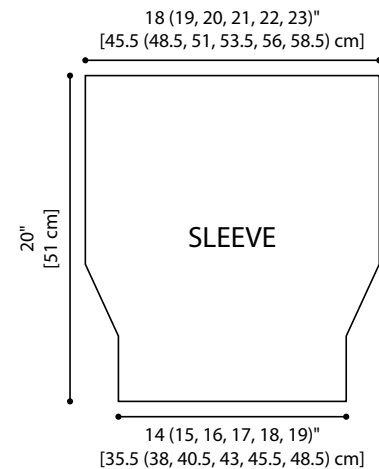
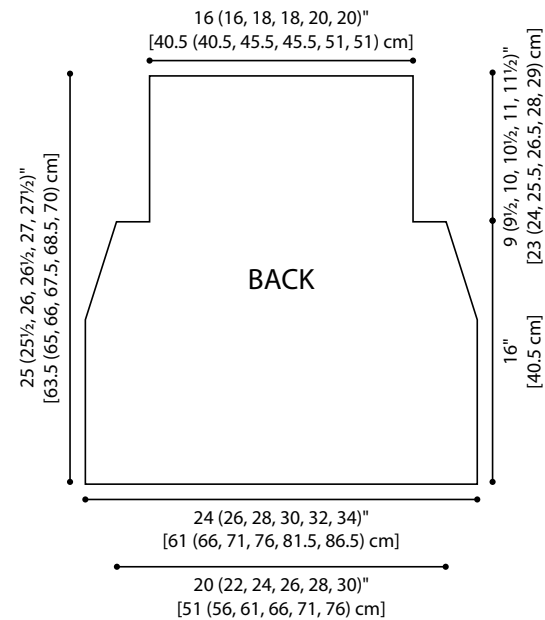
Matching the center of the top of the Sleeve to the shoulder seam, sew Sleeves in place.

Sew side and Sleeve seams.

Weave in ends.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**k2tog** = knit next 2 stitches together; **st(s)** = stitch(es).



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
