What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby Cotton™: 1 ball each 7760 Lemony **A**, 7501 Caribbean **B**, 7230 Peachy **C** and 7503 Lavender **D**

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.

BUY YARN



RED HEART® Scrubby Cotton™, Art. E854 available

in solid color 3.5 oz (100 g) 145 yd (133 m), prints 3 oz (85 g) 121 yd (110 m) balls



Two-Color Small Flowers

These small flowers are just right for washing your face. Crochet one for each day of the week and then just wash them by machine with the weekly laundry. Gift them to someone special with a small luxury like a candle or nice face soap.

Flower is 3¾" (9.5 cm) in diameter.

FLOWER

(make 3: 1 each with A & B, A & C, and A & D)

With **A**, ch 4; join with slip st to form a ring.

Round 1 (right side): Ch 4 (counts as first sc, ch 3), *sc in ring, ch 3; repeat from * 6 times; join with slip st in first ch of beginning ch—7 ch-3 sps. Fasten off.

Note: Hold piece with right side facing and push each ch-3 toward center as Round 2 is worked.

Round 2: Inserting hook through wrong side of ch-3 spaces and then in center of ring, join 2nd color with slip st in any ch-3 space, ch 3 (counts as first sc, ch 2), sc in next ch-3 space, ch 2; repeat from * 5 times; join with slip st in base of beginning ch—6 ch-2 sps.

Round 3: Slip st in first ch-2 space, (ch 3, dc, 2 tr, dc, ch 3, slip st) in same space (petal made), (slip st, ch 3, dc, 2 tr, dc, ch 3, sl st) in each ch-2 space around; join in beginning slip st—6 petals. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.;
ch = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet;
sc = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es);
tr = treble (triple) crochet; **()** = work directions in parentheses into same st; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.



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
