What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby™: 1 ball 982 Zesty A

COATS® Crème de la Crème®: 1 ball 935 Taffy Stripes Ombre B

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.

BUY YARN



RED HEART® Scrubby™, Art. E833 available in solids 3.5 oz (100 g), 92 yd (85 m), prints 3.0 oz (85 g) 78 yds (71 m) balls

BUY YARN



COATS® Crème de la Crème®, Art. 149 available in solid color 125 yd and shaded color 98 yd balls



Flower Power Scrubby

Put a little oomph in your dishcloth! This Scrubby flower is crocheted with textured Scrubby Cotton in the center and then edged with a scallop of smooth cotton yarn in a matching multi color. It's perfect for use in kitchen or bath!

Scrubby measures 5" (12.7 cm) in diameter.

FLOWER

With **A**, ch 3; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, 6 sc in ring; join with slip st in first sc—6 sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc—12 sc.

Round 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next st, *2 sc in next st, sc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc—18 sc.

Round 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 2 sts, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc—24 sc.

Round 5: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 3 sts, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc—30 sc.

Round 6: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 4 sts, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc—36 sc. Fasten off.

Round 7: With right side facing, join **B** with slip st in any st, ch 1, sc in same st as join, skip next st, 5 dc in next st, *skip next st, sc in next st, skip next st, 5 dc in next st; repeat from * around, skip last st; join with slip st in first sc—9 sc and 45 dc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

A, B = Color A, Color B; **ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.



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
